weeks.)" The building boom that was to fling factories, houses, shops and roads over market gardens and orchards was soon to come and with it the change to home ownership that is now established in Moorabbin.

Another twenty seven years will bring us to the end of the century. What changes would we like to see in Moorabbin by then? Perhaps our shopping centres, now so inconvenient and dangerous, will be replaced by malls; already this is mooted in Bentleigh. Perhaps our cultural life will be enriched by an arts centre with a theatre and concert hall and display rooms. Perhaps we will solve the litter problem, discover more ways to beautify the harsh highways, pull down the hideous gasometers at Highett and replace them with a park. And that should give us plenty to do.
