Jesse and Florence were married on the 19th March 1913 in Pendleton, England; they had their first five children there. Florence and Gloria were born in Australia.

Jesse came to Australia alone, in 1923, on the ship "SS Berrimer", to arrange a home for his wife and family, Florence and the children followed 12 months later, in 1924, aboard the ship "SS Bendigo".

They bought a block of land at 35 Sherbourne Road, Briar Hill, where, Jesse built a weatherboard house.

When the depression of the 1930's came, Jesse lost his job as a Wood Machinist. He was out of work for awhile, and then worked in the country in the forests, cutting trees, it was here he developed pneumonia, and later Parkinson's disease was unable to work. Florence and the older children had to work to support the family. Prior to 1931, they moved to Gladstone Road.

Census Records show: In 1947 when Jesse died, his wife Florence, daughter Florence, son Doug and his wife Dorothy were living in Gladstone Road. Florence (mother) lived there until her death in 1961.

Jessie Wilders was living in Sherbourne Road.

Also, in 1954 Kathleen Middleton was living in Mountain View Road,

Russell Gast. Middleton was living in Mountain View Road,

Gloria Ada Middleton (dressmaker) was living in Sherbourne Road,

Maurice Edw Middleton was living in Para Road.
