A KEY DATE

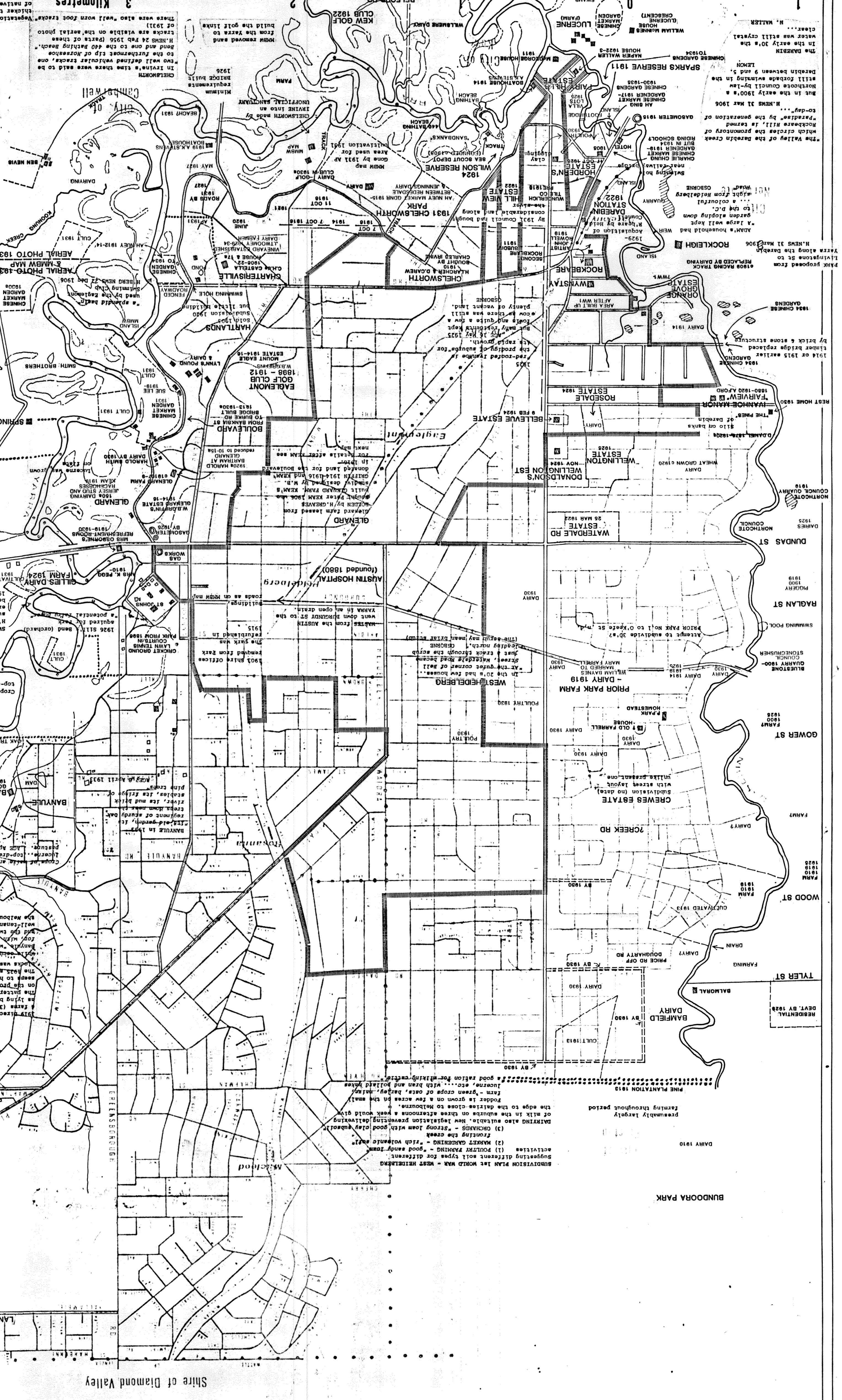
1921 The town was given control over waterworks and drains in the metropolitan area.
