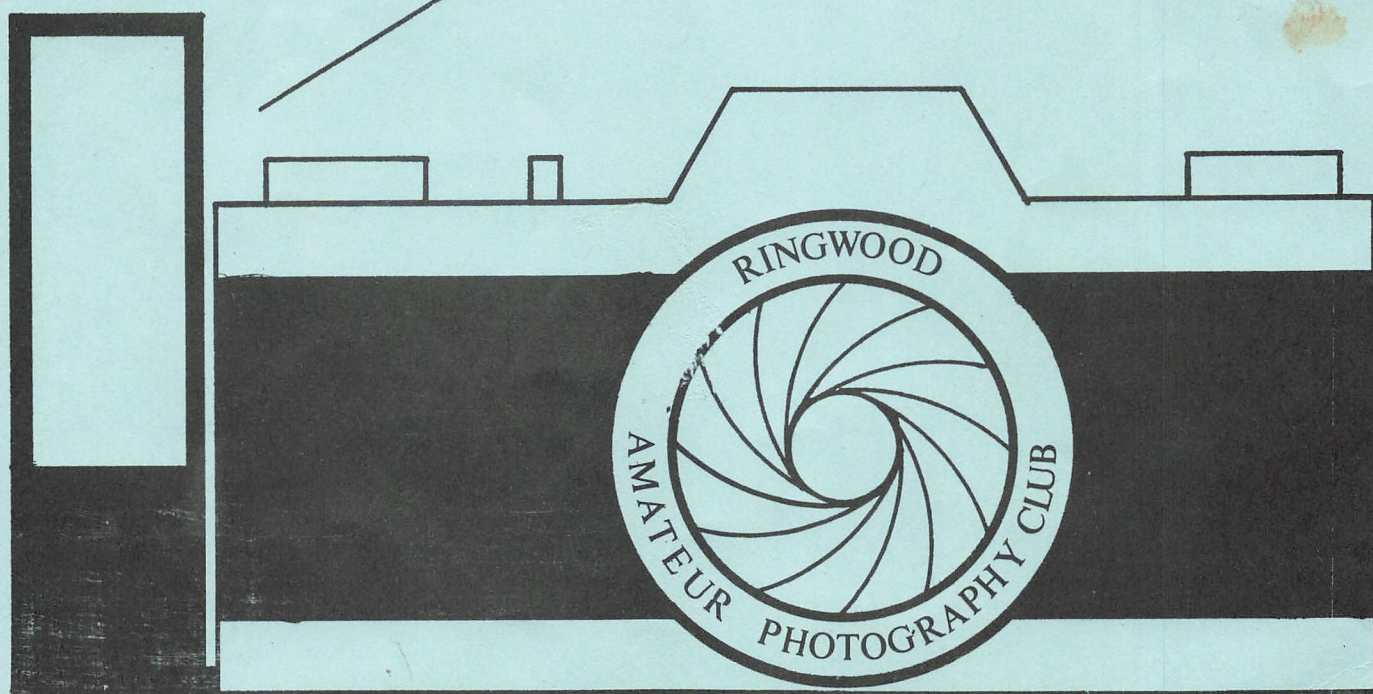

## THE RINGWOOD AMATEUR PHOTOGRAPHY CLUB - IT'S BEGINNINGS

Unfortunately dates are not available, but early in 1958 a small notice appeared in the window of Peter Payens Studio situated at the top of the Drive-in Arcade at 86 Whitehorse Road, Ringwood.

This small notice invited anyone interested in learning about the fundamentals of photography to leave their names within and should there be a sufficient number interested they would be notified and a date nominated for a beginners class.

Some three months later this advice was forthcoming and classes began, the main lecturer at the time being Mr. Dick Barnes. A series of four lectures were given covering different types of cameras, their features, depth of field, flash photography, composition, ratio of colour in colour photography compared with black and white and many other topics.

At the end of the lectures, the majority of those in attendance were enthusiastic to have more instruction. Further discussions then took place and the date for a meeting was made. At that meeting the Ringwood Amateur Photography Club was born. The next item was to draw up a constitution and elect a committee to run the Club according to its constitution.

From this humble beginning it is a credit to all those who have helped in the Club's functioning over the last 21 years and have made it competitive with other clubs throughout Victoria.

Congratulations Ringwood Amateur Photography Club for your 21st Birthday.

Looking back over the first twenty-one years of the Ringwood Amateur Photography Club brings to mind some of the activities and some of the problems, not the least of which was our meeting rooms.

During the first few years, while the membership was relatively small, we were fortunate to have the use of Peter Payens Studio in Ringwood Arcade. Our numbers were increasing constantly and by 1962 we had outgrown the studio. However, as luck would have it, one of our club members, Stan Dobbins, had just opened the Ringwood Camera Centre on the corner of the Ringwood Arcade and Whitehorse Road. He allowed the Club to meet in the shop for over three years - then we had to move again.

This time, through the generosity of Club members, Mr. & Mrs. Ernest Gallus, the Club was offered the use of a shed on their poultry farm in Centre Road, Vermont. This shed was of suitable size but only consisted of four walls and a roof. The committee put the question to the members "Could it be made into a Club room?" It would require some money and a great deal of hard work. The decision was to give it a go and after three months it was a credit to all who had lined the walls and painted the interior, attended to the electricity and plumbing, laid a floor and carpeted it, bought and installed the seating. During the next five years members had unlimited access to this room for committee meetings, sub-groups and black and white printing evenings.

This was a great period in the Club's history. However, as time passed it became necessary to sub-divide the poultry farm which meant the Club was again looking for a meeting room.

An application was made to the Ringwood Council for a meeting place and it was in August 1970 that the Club moved to the meeting room at the Ringwood Library in Warrandyte Road, Ringwood.

For the whole of the Club's history it has been affiliated with the Victorian Association of Photographic Societies with at least one member of the Club serving on the Executive Committee from 1964 to 1976. We had the honour of conducting the Inter-Club Competitions in 1965 and with an entry each year since 1961, we have had a fair measure of success.

On the social side, picnic days have always been popular with a barbecue lunch, billy tea, a day in the country where children and adults enjoyed themselves.

The preparations for this 21st Anniversary have been interesting and exciting. During the period I have been collecting information for the history, I have contacted many past members, renewing acquaintances and reminiscing on the past. The assistance given and valuable slides and prints lent for duplication, is very much appreciated.

Over the years some 250 to 300 people have joined the Club; people from all walks of life and covering a wide age group. Many have attended for years, some just a short time, contributing to the Club by attending, entering competitions, lecturing, taking part in practical sessions, enjoying outings, weekends, conventions and entertainment together.

Perhaps the success of the Club is shown best by the number of members who have achieved honours and acceptances in National, International and Photoflora Exhibitions, from the early days of the Melbourne International Salon to the present time. Also in V.A.P.S. Inter-club slide competitions where in 1963 we were placed 2nd in Section 1 only .63 behind the winners - in 1971 and 1972 we came 3rd in Section 2 - in 1973, 1st in Section 2 and in 1974, 2nd in Section 2. Since 1974 an entry has been submitted in Section 3 for Prints with the best effort so far, a 4th Place in 1978. Over the years a number of slides and prints have been retained by V.A.P.S. for Victoria's entry in the National competitions bringing honour to both members and the Club as a whole. Recently Audio-Visuals have become popular with the Club winning the set subject section in 1977 and 1978.

A number of achievements such as new designs for competition certificates, syllabus and our own letterheads, the design and manufacture of our Club trophies and Club T shirts have all been the work of members - not entirely unrelated to photography as an art.

And what challenge does the future hold?

Surely the objects of the Club, as planned by the foundation members and written into the Constitution - "To provide and encourage meetings of members to facilitate the exchange of ideas for their mutual improvement in the knowledge and practice of photography and allied processes - To encourage the advancement of photography as a science and an art"-- still hold the challenge for today and the future.

We, the members, are the RINGWOOD AMATEUR PHOTOGRAPHY CLUB - we have a record of which we should be very proud.
