Enclosed is a copy of a page of Victoria Gazette No 81 8/10/1975 containing the notice of assignment of the name Harmony Vale.

This shows the background of the bulbs as historic artifacts. I also enclose a copy of Tales From the Dandenongs , No 7, which contain a study of the homestead "Harmony Vale".

And also a copy of Bryan Tonkin's letter to me anclosed with the bulbs.

My dearest wish is that two or three of the bulbs should be taken over by the Ringwood Council Nurseries with the object of nurturing them, giving them the special attention to documentation they call for.

They should have an attraction at the Miner's cottage as the Pioneers of Harmony Vale, Childs, Jeeves and Richardson, originally settled as miners.

I know the bulbs are of a common species probably the ones called "Wood Hyacinths". We had them or a similar species growing here years ago, but it does not matter. It is the special associations of the Harmony Vale ones that makes them valuable.

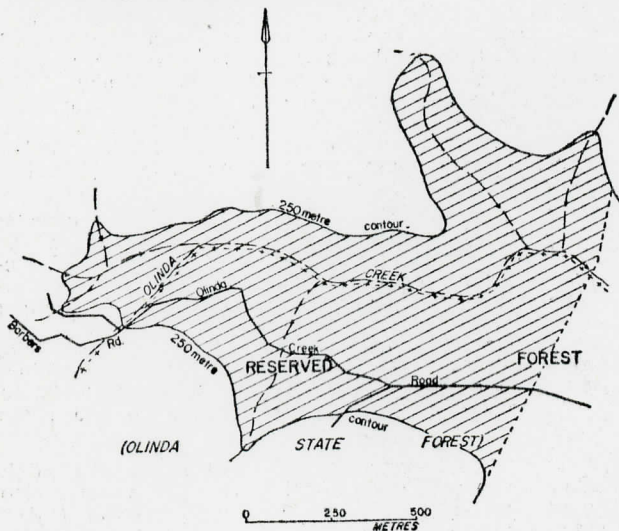

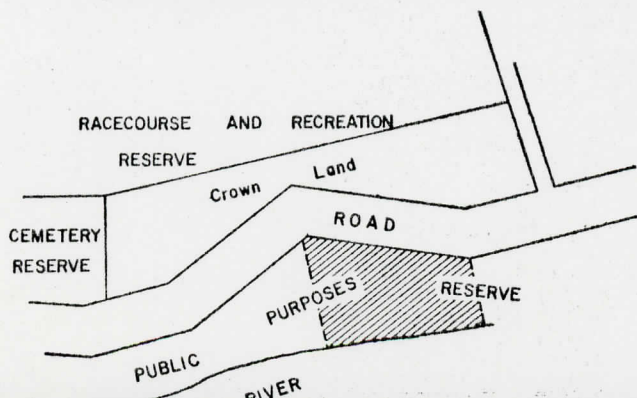
