- 1962 Leadership Training Commission Chairman. Represented Ringwood on reciprocal visit to Fiji.
- 1963 President. Elected unopposed to Ringwood Council.
- 1964 Chairman Long Range Planning Committee.
- 1965 Member Building Investigation Committee. Attended World Congress Sydney.
- 1966 Jargon Editor.
- 1967 Accommodation Officer, Organising Committee, Marysville Zone Conference.
- 1968 Member Vic. Zone Conservation Committee. National Convention Queensland. Elected Mayor, City of Ringwood.

Stan has been a consistently active member. His outstanding highlights of service have been the Fiji visit in 1962 and Zone Conference Organisation in 1967.
