# GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR COMPETITORS

1. All entries must be in writing on the Society's Entry Form and accompanied by fee and stamped, addressed envelope. All correspondence must be addressed to the Secretary, Mrs. W. P. BURGESS, Warrandyte Road, Ringwood. WU 7211.

2. The Committee reserves the right to award only one prize in the event of there being six or under entries.

3. All Open Section competitors must state on Entry Form the title of piece to be given. No alterations will be allowed without the consent of the Adjudicators.

4. In all competitions which are subject to an age limit, the age at closing of entries on July 16 will be deemed the competitor's age.

5. Copies of Own Choice items must be provided for the Adjudicator and be in the hands of the Secretary 48 hours before the commencement of the competitions.

6. Competitors will receive a timetable, showing date and time of appearance.

7. Any competitors not appearing when called upon may be liable to disqualification.

8. Adjudicators' decision shall be final. All other disputes shall be dealt with by the Committee.

9. A Grand Concert will be given on August 27 by 1st Prizewinners. The final of the area will be held on this night. All prizes to be presented at Grand Concert.

10. Official accompanists will be provided by the Society, but a competitor may bring own accompanist if desired. Such accompanist must, however, pay for admission. Advice is desired if own accompanist is to appear.

11. Stamps will not be accepted as Entry Fees. All Postal Orders must be made payable at Ringwood Post Office.

12. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry.

13. All vocal items to be sung in English. Light refreshments will be sold at Interval.
