RULES

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. Date of all sections entered will be given on appearance cards.
2. Closing date will be strictly adhered to - no late entries will be accepted.
3. Entry fees will be 20 cents per dance except Trios-Duos which will be 10 cents per competitor.
4. Stamps will NOT be accepted as entry fees or part thereof.
5. All Postal Orders to be made payable to RINGWOOD EISTEDDFOD.
6. A stamped self-addressed envelope MUST be enclosed with each entry form.
7. A limit of 3½ minutes will be enforced on all items.
8. Troupes must consist of not less than six and not more than ten and all names to be supplied.
9. First prize only will be awarded in any section with less than six competitors.
10. Prizes will be medals for 1st and 2nd and Certificates for 3rd and Honorable Mention unless otherwise specified.
11. There will be ten Orders of \$2.00 each, donated by Martin's Ballet Boutique, awarded in sections to be announced.
12. Novice means a competitor not having gained 1st, 2nd or 3rd place in any Eisteddfod in the section they wish to enter, at the closing date of entries.
13. The age of the competitor will be taken as on the closing date, viz. 15th June, 1970.
14. Competitors must provide own accompanist at all times.
15. All prizes will be awarded at the Grand Concert when first prize winners will perform unless otherwise advised. Non-appearance may render forfeiture of prizes.
16. Points for Aggregates will be allotted as follows:-

1st	-	5 points
2nd	-	3 points
3rd	-	1 point
17. Aggregate Trophies. THE FRANK GRAY TROPHY will be donated by the Society to the senior (11 years and over) competitor gaining the highest number of points. A JUNIOR TROPHY will be awarded to the competitor under 11 years gaining the highest number of points. (Solo items only will be counted).

Trophies will also be awarded to the competitors (senior and junior) gaining the highest number of points in classical sections only (Solo items only counted).
