### **MEMORIAL GARDENS**

Both Heathmont and Ringwood East memorial gardens are now ready for transfer to Lilydale Memorial Park. The management of Lilydale Memorial Park will soon arrange for the excavation, transport to Lilydale and restitution of the church gardens ready for us to replant as gardens if we so wish. Information in our burial registers will be used for the names, dates of birth and death, and the addresses of the deceased at the time of death - all of this will be advised to Lilydale Memorial Park management. When the names of the deceased people are engraved onto plaques and affixed to a large rock at the chosen Lilydale site, a dedication service will be arranged and relatives informed. This is not expected to occur until March or April 2008 or even later. All concerned people will be invited to this dedication. If you know of folk who are interested in this event, could you please pass on this information to them and advise us of their addresses if they wish to be invited.
