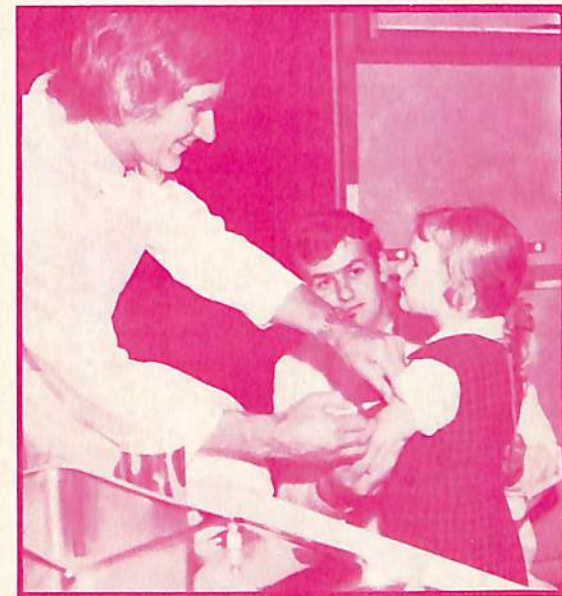


HOW YOUR COUNCIL'S EXPENDITURE IS APPORTIONED
