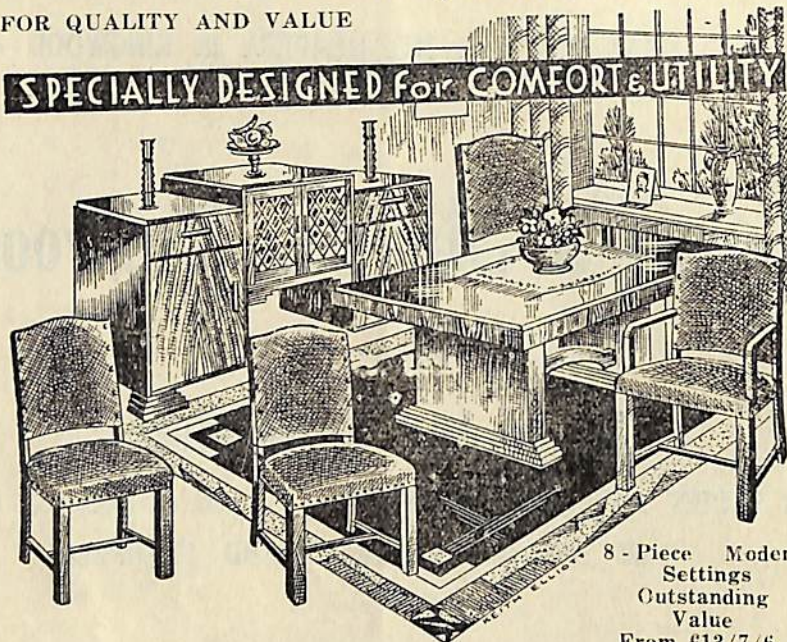

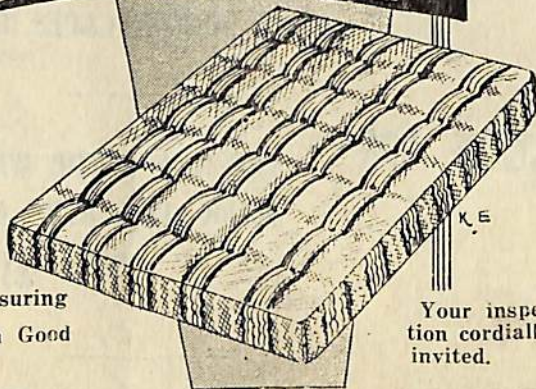

REGULATIONS

1. Exhibits to be staged at 11 a.m. sharp on April 3rd.
2. The Show will open at 1.30 to 6 p.m. afternoon sessions, and from 6.45 to 10 p.m. night sessions.
3. The Poultry Section will be conducted under the Regulations of the Poultry Control Council, including all rules relating to conditions of sale, protests and fraudulent practices of conduct.
4. All Poultry exhibits must be bona fide property of the exhibitor at least 14 days prior to Show.
5. All entries are received subject to these regulations, and to all others as set out herein. In case of any dispute, the Committee's decision to be final.
6. All Poultry must be at the Ringwood Town Hall by 10.30 a.m. on day of Show. Exhibits conveyed from and to Ringwood railway station free of charge. All stock exhibits failing to arrive in time for judging will be fed and watered and returned to their owners after the Show. All Budgerigars to be benched by 10.30 p.m., Thursday, April 2nd.
7. The greatest care will be taken of all exhibits, country and interstate having special attention, but the Committee will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage from whatever cause arising.
8. During the Show the exhibits will be under the control of the Committee, and must not be touched or handled by the owner, or any other unauthorised person under any circumstances.
9. No exhibit may be removed before 5.30 p.m. on Saturday, April 4, and exhibitors must produce their card to the Stewards in charge before delivery.
10. Leg bands must be removed from all poultry, or they will be disqualified.

11. Any exhibit entered in the wrong class will necessarily be disqualified from competition and any live stock suffering from contagious disease will be removed.

12. Exhibits can only be entered in one class.

13. No exhibitor or other person shall be admitted to the exhibits (except those actually engaged in the arrangements) previous to the hour of opening.

14. All fruit, flower and vegetable exhibits must have been grown by the exhibitor, and pot plants must have been in the possession of the exhibitor at least 14 days prior to day of Show.

15. The work of school children, unless otherwise specified, must be done at the registered school.

16. Sale of Live Stock.—Any exhibitor wishing to offer his stock for sale, if Secretary is notified, a price card will be placed on the exhibit after judging. A commission of 10 per cent. will be deducted to all sales.

17. No exhibits will be allowed to compete unless entry fee has been paid.

18. Where entries do not exceed three in any particular class, a first prize and 2nd certificate only will be awarded.

19. The judges may withhold any prize or card where the quality of the exhibit is considered of not sufficient merit.

20. No protest will be entertained except it be made in writing to the Secretary before 4 p.m. on the day of Show. Cash deposit of 10/- must accompany the protest, such sum to be forfeited if the protest be deemed frivolous.

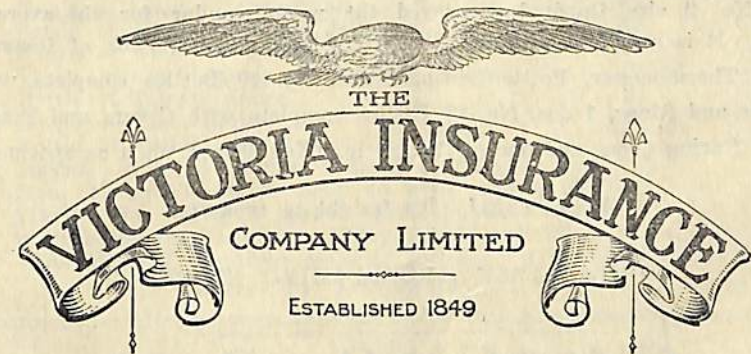

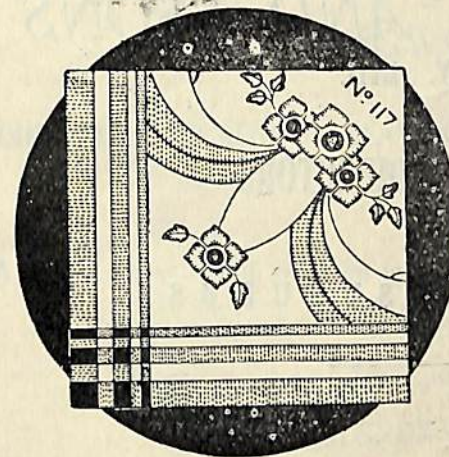

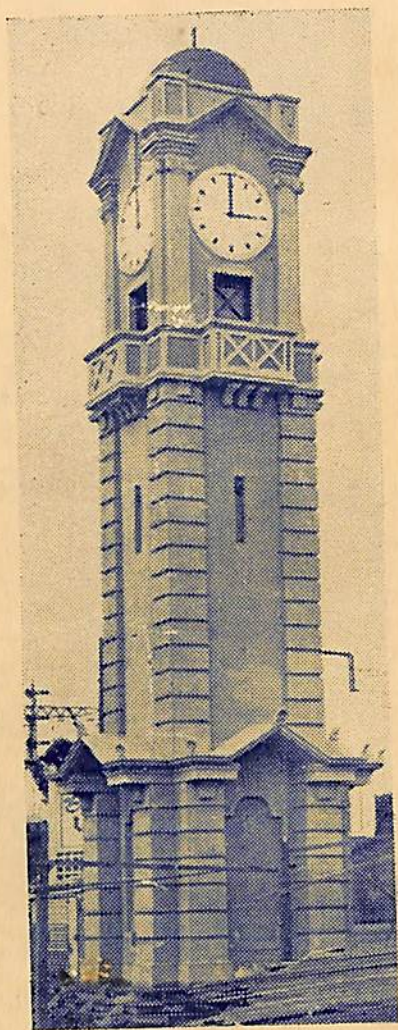
