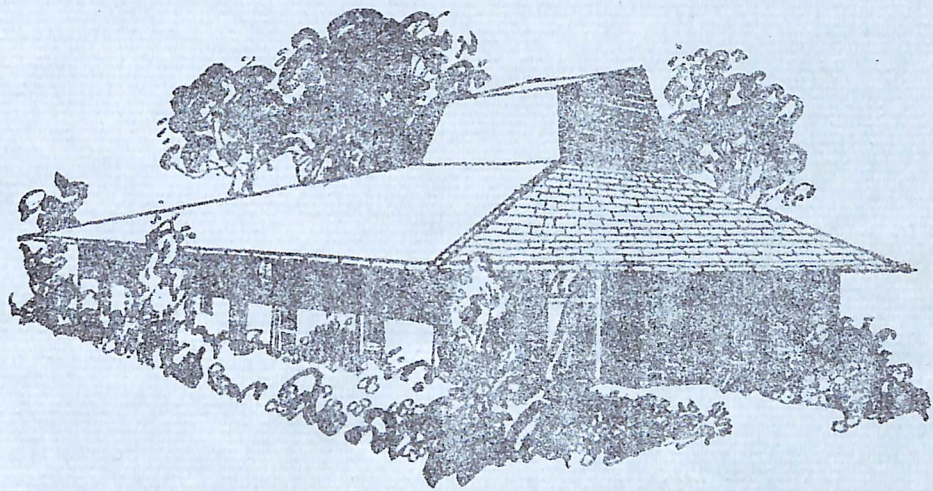

REFLECTING ON THE CONSECRATION OF OUR CHURCH
