GIRLS' TECHNICAL SCHOOLS

Aims

- 1 To continue the general education of girls from Grade VI and higher standard to Secondary level.
- 2 To give them preparatory and pre-vocational training in humanities, art, commerce, science, needlecrafts and homecrafts.
- 3 To assist girls, by means of this training, to determine the type of professional, technical, commercial or industrial work for which they are best suited.
- 4 To qualify girls to continue with Senior Technical or Diploma Courses.



Course of Study for First and Second Years

GROUPS	SUBJECTS
<i>Humanities</i>	English Social Studies Music Christian Education
<i>Maths and Science</i>	Mathematics Science
<i>Physical Education</i>	Sport Physical Education
<i>Practical Subjects</i>	Art and Craft Homecrafts Needlecrafts

In third and fourth years, the course is continued, except that the time given to practical subjects is adjusted for commercial or professional courses as selected by the student.

The Junior Technical Certificate may be awarded at the end of the third year, and the Intermediate Technical Certificate at the end of the fourth year.

TUITION IS FREE, but a small composite fee is charged to cover materials, locker, sports and library. The cost of books is kept low. *School uniform is essential.*

Technical School Training prepares girls

FOR THE FOLLOWING CAREERS:

- 1 **Commercial:** Teacher of Commerce, Stenographer, Typist, Secretary, Accountant, Clerk in Office—Bank—Insurance Office, Bursar in School.
- 2 **Art:** Teacher of Art and Craft, Architect, Commercial Artist, Fabric Printer, Tracer.
- 3 **Homecraft:** Teacher of Cookery, Dietitian, Demonstrator, Canteen Manageress, School Matron or Housekeeper, Trade or Hospital Cook, Nurse, Mothercraft Nurse, Dental Nurse.
- 4 **Applied Science:** Teacher of Science, Applied Scientist, Industrial Chemist, Laboratory Assistant, Textile Chemist.
- 5 **Needlecraft:** Teacher of Needlecraft, Dress Designer, Cutter, Dressmaker, Machinist, Tailoress.
