William Knee came from England to Victoria and maried Miss Phillips from South Australia they settled in Deep Creek (near East Doncaster) and had eight children; William married Annie Lyall, East Doncaster

Thomas married Sarah Hardidge Croydon Rose married Charles Pickering, Kew Kate married Fredrick Wilson, Doncaster Louisa married Charles Marshall, Box Hill George married Alice Lyall, East Doncaster James never married Emily married Robert Whittlesea, Gawler, S.A.

HARDIDGE FAMILY

Mr Hardidge married Miss Williams in England before sailing to Australia in 1885 and settled on a 100 acre plot at Birt's Hill and had six children; Emily married Mark Adams, Templestove

Mary married W.Bislop, Doncaster Sarah married Thomas Knee, Doncaster Samuel married Amelia Bilcock, Croydon Amelia married Walter Goodwin, Croydon William never married, died in his early twenties.

DICKSON FAMILY

George Dickson married Jane Walker in Seagoe, North Ireland on 2nd June 1810. They had a son James born 1812 (dec 1874) who married Elizabeth Walker on the 28th June 1832.

They had two sons. Thomas (1840) and Moses (1841) who came to Australia in 1861. Moses married Elizabeth Sargeant at Christ Church Hawthorn on the 10th February, 1865.

SARGEANT FAMILY

Robert (1766) married (Ann) Nancy Stewart (1766) in 1796 in North Ireland. Their son Stewart Sargeant (1808) married Elizabeth Bradford in 1830, their daughter Elizabeth married Moses Dickson in 1865 at Christ Church Hawthorn. (Elizabeth was the fourth of eight children of Stewart and Elizabeth).

Moses and Elizabeth had ten children:

MOSES



FRANCES

Moses Dickson Snr. arrived in Australia, disembarking at Melbourne on the 1st November 1861. He had travelled on the "Elizabeth Bright" a ship of 1919 tons embarking from Liverpool with 458 other passengers on the 12th of August 1861.

Testimony about his arrival shows that he arrived with his brother Thomas. Moses was 19 and Thomas 20 and both were described as Irish labourers and single.

When Moses Dickson married Elizabeth Sargeant both were 23 years of age. Witnesses to the wedding were Richard Carson (a cousin) and Robert Sargeant (bride's brother).

Moses and Elizabeth had a small farm near the north east corner of Middleborough Road and Maroondah Highway in the first years of their married life. In 1875 the family moved to Ringwood where they purchased 121 acres bounded by Loughnan, Oban and Warrandyte Roads. This property was later lost in the economic crash of the late 19th century and the family later purchased a property on the corner of Warrandyte and Oban Roads Ringwood North, Moses and Elizabeth built their house close to Warrandyte Road. Moses Snr. died in 1904 following a stroke at the age of 63. He had worked as a farmer, woodcarter and died an orchardist. He passed on his skills to his sons, Stewart, Moses and Alfred and these skills followed into the succeeding generations. His wife Elizabeth died of blood poisoning following an infection after working in the garden. Elizabeth has been described as being a very happy bright person with auburn hair.

Before the building of churches in the area church meetings were held in the homes of the early settlers including the farm house of Moses and Elizabeth Dickson.

When Moses Snr. died Moses Jnr. and his wife Frances purchased the property from the family, where they lived for the remainder of their lives. Unfortunatly the old family home was entirely lost in a fire in 1961 and with it went many family records. The property was later sub-divided into housing blocks and a shopping centre in Warrandyte Road North Ringwood. Some of these shops are still owned by Moses descendants.

There was a time some years ago when you could stand in the middle of the North Ringwood oval in Wonga Road and look at all the orchards in view knowing that the fruit trees had all been planted by some member or descendant of the Dickson Family.

Moses and Elizabeth Dickson and family were true pioneers who helped shape the history and developments of Ringwood.



Moses John was born on the 23rd December 1875 on the family property in Warrandyte Road Ringwood North. He married Frances Knee at Doncaster in 1903 and settled in Croydon where they had an orchard, they then shifted to Ringwood North where they purchased the family orchard on the death of Moses Senior in 1904.

They had four sons and three daughters, twelve grand-daughters and seven grand-sons. Of their seven children six have settled on the land. Leslie had an orchard in Warradyte Road, Mavis (Goulding) had an orchard in Wonga Road North Ringwood, Myrtle (Wooley) on an orchard





in Red Hill. John had an orchard in North Ringwood, and a dairy farm in Yarroweyah. Ron had a property in Ringwood North and a farm at Euroa. Bill had an orchard at North Ringwood and a farm at Euroa. Lil (Milne) was the only one who didn't settle on the land, conducted the general store and post office in North Ringwood.

Moses had the honour in 1953 and 1954 of unfurling the flag at the Australia Day carnival in Ringwood as he was the oldest Ringwood born citizen at that time. Frances died of a heart attack in 1950 and Moses in 1954 both are buried at the Box Hill cemetery.

LESLIE ALFRED

LESLIE ALFRED was the first child of Moses and Frances born on the 26/11/1904. Leslie worked on the orchard in Warrandyte Road Ringwood North and married Florence Eva Neill at St Georges Church of England Malvern in 1937. Leslie and Flo lived in Warrandyte Road Ringwood North on the opposite side of the road to the family property where he had an orchard and helped with his fathers orchard.

They had one child, Ian Leslie born on the 23/4/1938 who married Barbara Lacey at St Pauls Church of England Boronia in 1964. They have four daughters. Karen Jean 18/3/1966, Janet Elizabeth 13/3/1969, Narelle Joy 30/11/1972 and Alison Maree 4/5/1976.

lan has a grazing property at Euroa and resides on a grazing property at Yarra Glen. Ian has a shop at the North Ringwood Shopping Cente and it is leased out to a dry cleaning business.

Leslie died in 1960 and Florence died in 1965 and they are buried at Lilydale cemetery.

MAVIS DULCIE

MAVIS DULCIE was the second child of Moses and Frances born on 20/8/1905. After leaving school worked as a home help. Mavis married Frederick Goulding at Church of England Ringwood in 1929. Fred was a paper boy outside Flinders Street Station at the young age of 5 helping to support his family as his father had died earlier. In his late teens he worked on an orchard in Park Orchards.

After Mavis and Fred were married they moved to Deepdene to live. Fred worked as a glass beveller for 25 years at Abbotsford. They bought an orchard in Wonga Road North Ringwood in 1941. Fred died in 1962 and Mavis died in 1972, they are both buried at the Lilydale cemetery.


Mavis and Fred had five children, Merle Frances born 11/11/1931 and married Douglas Allan Hose at the Church of England Ringwood in 1953. They had three children. MYRTLE ROSE second daughter of Moses and Frances was born on 18/10/1907 at Ringwood North. Myrtle stayed at home helping in the family home after leaving school until her marriage to Arthur James Wooley at St Pauls Church of England Ringwood in 1929. Arthur was a plumber until he bought a truck in shares with Myrtle's brother John which they used for carting for approximately three years. After they sold the truck Arthur and Myrtle shifted to Red Hill in 1939 where they conducted an orchard and flower farm. In 1968 they bought a caravan park at Dromana and ran it very successfully until they retired to Manna Street Dromana in 1973.

Myrtle and Arthur have three sons; Kevin Arthur born on 17/10/1929 married June Griffiths at the Church of England Dromana in 1953 and had two daughters. Diane Maree 3/3/1955 and Jennifer Gaye 22/9/1957. Kevin is a landscape gardener and lives in Dromana.

Raymond John born 6/2/1933 and married Leah Venturin at the Catholic Church Dromana in 1956. They have two sons. Rodney David 4/4/1959 and Peter John 18/6/1961. Ray has a poultry farm at Red Hill.

EDWIN JOHN (JOHN) was the second son of Moses and Frances born on the 27/12/1909 and married Winifred May (Dolly) McGrath at Holy Trinity Church of England Thornbury in 1930. John and Dolly lived on their orchard in Ringwood North until 1952 when they sold out and bought an orchard in Kyabram but in 1955 the floods ruined the orchard so they converted their property to a dairy farm which they sold in 1960. John and Dolly then bought a dairy farm at Yarroweyah and later when John semi retired they moved to Cobram and their youngest son Graham managed the farm.

John and Dolly had five children, Neville John born on the 13/5/1931 who married Joyce May Coram at the Methodist Church Kyabram in 1954 they had four children. Susan (dec) 1955, Gary David 3/8/1956, Judith Rebecca May 12/1/1958, Sandra Leanne 1/8/1959. Neville and Joyce conduct a mixed business and live in Kyabram.

Lillian married Kenneth Mervyn Milne in 1935 at St Pauls Church of England Ringwood and they lived at the rear of their general store on the corner of Warrandyte and Oban Roads Ringwood North all their married life. Before they were married Lil was a dressmaker at Glenferrie and Kenneth was a cabinet maker at Richmond. Kenneth was also a very talented pianist and had his own dance band for many years.

They had three children. Betty Lillian born 31/8/1936 who married James Robert (Bob) Young at St Pauls Church of England Ringwood in 1955. They have four children. Karen Anne 3/6/1956, Steven Robert 12/4/1958, Linda Gaye 2/8/1960 and Michael Kenneth 2/12/1961. Bob is a builder and they live in Yarra Glen.

Garry Kenneth was born on 8/8/1939 and married Beverly Ann Parnell at St Johns Church of England Camberwell in 1964. They have two children Larrissa Joy 13/3/1969 and David James 9/3/1973. Garry is a company director and lives in North Ringwood.

RONALD KENNETH

RONALD KENNETH was the sixth child of Moses and Frances born on 27/10/1915. Ron opened his own garage on the family property in 1937 at the age of 22. In June 1940 he joined the army and sailed overseas on the Queen Mary from the Sydney Harbour on Christmas Day 1940.

Ron married Gwen Williams in Gwens Family Garden at Park Orchard in 1942. After completing active duty in 1946, Ron and Gwen opened a fruit and vegetable shop in Whitehorse Road Ringwood with a starting bank balance of only \$112. They ran this very successfully until they sold out in 1957. Ron then did two years at the Victorian Market conducting a pea and bean stand

In 1950 while running the fruit shop Ron and a friend Dolp Hunt constructed a building from Austin car crates in which they opened the Ringwood Dry Cleaners and ran it with the help of managers for 25 years. In 1975 they sold the business and leased the premises. In 1959 Ron obtained an estate agent and auctioneers licence and worked for his brother Bill for 10 years.

In 1965 Ron opened the North Ringwood butchers shop and in 1969 he sold the business and leased the premises, he also obtained another shop site and started a Doctor's surgery in North Ringwood when the Doctor moved to his own premises the ANZ bank took over the lease. In 1978 Ron and Gwen purchased the "Spring View" property in Euroa which is a sheep farm of 533 acres. At this time Ron is starting to breed stud cattle as well. Ron resides between his home in Warrandyte Road Ringwood North and his home on his property at Euroa.

AUBREY WESLEY (BILL) youngest child of Moses and Frances was born on the 3/9/1919. Bill left school at the age of 14 and worked for his sister and brother-in-law, Lil and Ken in their general store for 5 years until he joined the army.

Bill married Estelle Violet White at St Andrews Church of England Box Hill in 1942. After leaving the army Bill and Stella had a milk bar in Whitehorse Road Ringwood which they sold in 1946. Bill became a real estate agent in June 1946 and opened his own agency which he still conducts in Ringwood with his son Alan who is now managing the business. Alan obtained a full estate agents licence at 22 years of age.

In 1947, Bill and Stella bought a property in Warrandyte Road Ringwood North and built their home there in 1948. In 1977 Bill bought a 1,700 acre property at Euroa which his son Wayne manages. They run cattle and sheep and grow oats. Bill opened three shops at the North Ringwood shopping centre they are a milk bar, hairdressers and a take away food shop. These are all leased to private businesses.

Bill and Stella have two sons. Wayne Lindsay born on the 14/4/1951 who married Hilary Joy Robertson at Scots Church Ringwood in 1973. They have two children; Amber Joy born 27/9/1973 and Scott Aubrey born 21/3/1978. Wayne and Hilary live on the family property at Euroa. Alan Wesley born on the 16/10/1956 married Geraldine Vanessa Baier at Holy Trinity Church of England Kew in 1980. Alan is an estate agent and lives in North Ringwood.







The State School No. 4120 first opened in Oban Road North Ringwood in 1923 where the four youngest children of Moses and Frances completed their education. The school opened with fifteen pupils on the first day and by the end of the first year the number had increased to twenty four pupils.

In 1929 the single class room had to be enlarged and in 1955 and in 1968 additional class rooms were added. Most of Moses and Frances grandchildren attended North Ringwood school and some of their descendants are being educated at the school at this time, therefore there has been a Dickson or a Dickson descendant at the school ever since it opened.
