LIONS CODE OF ETHICS

TO SHOW my faith in the worthiness of my vocation by industrious application to the end that I may merit a reputation for quality of service.

TO SEEK success and to demand all fair remuneration or profit as my just due, but to accept no profit or success at the price of my own self-respect lost because of unfair advantage taken or because of questionable acts on my part.

TO REMEMBER that in building up my business it is not necessary to tear down another's; to be loyal to my clients or customers and true to myself.

WHENEVER a doubt arises as to the right or ethics of my position or action towards my fellow men, to resolve such doubt against myself.

TO HOLD friendship as an end and not a means. To hold that true friendship exists not on account of the service performed by one to another, but that true friendship demands nothing but accepts service in the spirit in which it is given.

TO BE CAREFUL with my criticism and liberal with my praise; to build up and not destroy.

ALWAYS bear in mind my obligation as a citizen to my nation, my state and my community, and to give them my unswerving loyalty in word, act and deed. To give them freely of my time, labour and means.

TO AID my fellow men by giving my sympathy to those in distress, my aid to the weak, and my substance to the needy.

LIONS CLUB OBJECTS

- (a) To create and foster a spirit of understanding among the peoples of the world through a study of the problems of international relationships.
- (b) To promote the principles of good government and good citizenship.
- (c) To take an active interest in the civic, cultural, social and moral welfare of the community.
- (d) To unite the clubs in the bonds of friendship, good fellowship and mutual understanding.
- (e) To provide a forum for the open discussion of all matters of public interest; provided, however, that partisan politics and secretarian religion shall not be debated by club members.
- (f) To encourage service-minded men to serve their community without personal financial reward, and to encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in commerce, industry, professions, public works and private endeavours.



Fortunately, many areas in the eastern suburbs have escaped the progress of modern, urban development. Lakes and pockets of un-tamed bushland still inspire the imagination of artists who are keen to capture the beauty of the local environment. This was the aim of the late Dick Ovenden in wishing to see held an annual art show which would reflect the charm of the region and inspire the talents of artists who shared his appreciation. We are grateful to all artists who have participated in this year's showing.

The Eastern Suburbs Lions Clubs comprising Bennettswood, Box Hill, Forest Hill, Nunawading, Vermont, Ringwood and Blackburn North are thankful of the interest of artists and the community.

This year, art show profits are to be donated to Australia's newest charity which is also head-quartered in the eastern suburbs. It is the Osteogenesis Imperfecta Foundation.

This is an organisation formed to assist the families who suffer from the hereditary bone disorder after which the Foundation has been named. Simply it means this, that sufferers have extremely fragile bones which fracture frequently, sometimes at the slightest trauma, causing pain, often immobilisation and hospitalisation. It can cause crippling deformities in the severely affected and the problem blankets not only the individual patient but all family members.

Assistance is given through the self-help concept but also the Foundation is working towards supporting research into the condition and the establishment of improved treatment facilities for affected families. A young organisation, it has aims which reach out to help affected families in all parts of Australia, New Zealand and areas of Asia.

One of its most recent activities has been to bring from the United States, a world-acknowledged expert on the condition to pass on his findings to medical, paramedical, research and parent groups in Australia and New Zealand.

The Osteogenesis Imperfecta Foundation joins with its sister organisations in the U.S.A. and Great Britain to give help at person-to-person level and to seek a control, if not a cure of this crippling condition.

We are grateful for community support of this organisation, particularly in view of the fact that many of these patients are gifted intellectually and therefore, if given the opportunities educationally and morally have fine aptitudes and talents to return to the communities that have helped them initially.
