## NAZAE OF CLUE

1. The Club shall be cailed the RINGWOOD BOWLING CIUB.

2. The objects of the club are to provide for Bowling and Croquet ! r.play and to promote social intercourse between the menbers.

## COLOURS

3. The colours of the Club shall be such as the Conmittee from time to time may determine.

## OFFICERS

4. The Officers of the Club shall be the President, two VicePresidents, Hon. Treasurer, Hon. Secretary, Hono Bowling Secretary, Assistant Hon. Secretary. They shall be elected by ballot at each annual general meeting and shall hold Office until the naxt annual general meeting when they shall retire, but shall be eligible forfe-election.

## inANAGEIVENT

5. (a) The business of the Club shall be managed by a Committee of Management (hereinafter called the Committee) consisting of the President, two Vice Presidents, Hon. Treasurer, Hon. General Secretary, Hon. Bowling Seoretary, Hon. Assistant Secretary, and five other inembers of the Club, and seven of the Comittee shall forin a quorum.

The election of members to serve on the Committee shall be by ballot to be held at the annual general meeting. No person shall be nominated to act either as an officer or nember of the Comraittee without his verbal consent if present at the election or his written consent if absent.
(b) Any member of the Cominittee absenting himiself from three oonsecutive meetings without forwarding a satisisatory explanation shall be held to heve forfeited inis seat.
(c) Any casual vacancy among the officers or nembers of the comruittee shill be pilled by the committee, end any member chosen to fill such venancy shell retire at the next annual general meeting:
(d) The Comaittee, in addition to the powers herein specifically conferran upon thein, shall have control of the finances of the club, power to engage, control and disuiss Club servants and ali such abininistrative powers as nay be considered necessary for properly carrying out the objects of the Club in accordanse with these rules.
(e) The Conimittee shrll have the power to appoint a Lifnager who shall be a full bowing meiuber of the Club, such waneger shall have charge of and be responsible to the cominittee for all the personel property of the Club and shell represent

the Club in all matters pertaining to or proceedings relating to such property．
（f）If at any time the Club in general meeting shall yass a resolution authosising the Committee to borrow money，the Committee shall thereupon bo cmpowesed to borrow for purposes of the Club buth amount of money，either at one time or from time to time and at such rate of interest and in such form and manner and upon such security as shall be specified in such resolution and thereupon the Committee shall make all such dispositions of the Club property or any part thereof and enter into such agree－ ments in relation thereto as the Committee may deem proper for giving security for such loans and interest。 all members of the Club，whether voting on such resolution or not and all persons becoming members of the Glub after the passing of such resolution shall be deemed to have assented to the same as if they had roted in favor of such resolution．
（g）The Secretary shall conduct the correspondence of the Club and shall have the custody of all documents belonging to the Clu＊．He shall keep full and correct minutes se all proceedings and records of all competitions of the Club and shall also keep a register of all members of the Club。
（h）The Treasurer shall keep the accounts of the Club and shall make up the annuel statement of accounts and balance sheet of the Club to the 3lst day of July in each year，which shall be audited，and if directed by the Committee，be printed and circulated amongst the members prior to the annual general meeting，and receive all subscripions．from Mcmbers \＆intending （i）Two members shall be appointed auditors at the annual（Mombers． general mectingo They，or onc of thom，shall audit the annual statement of accounts and balance sheot and shall certify to the same．

## MEMBERSH IP

6 （a）Memborship and subscriptions shall be as arranged at each annual meeting of the Club．
Full bowling members only shall be allowed to vote at mectings of the Club，except that cach Dobenturc holdor shall be entitled to one vote irrcspoctive of whothor ho be a financial member or not．
（b）Any person wishing to become a member of the Glub must be proposed by one financial member of the Club and seconded by another．Nomination papers signed by the proposer and seconder and containing the address of tho candidate，must be dolircrod to the Secrctary，who shall post the namos of candidates on the notice boerd of the club one weck prior to tho election． New members must be approved by the Committee at their next mecting aftcr the expiration of seven days． （c）If a newly elected member fails to pay his subscription Within thirty days after his election，his glection shall be void unless he justifics the delay to the satisfaction of the Committee。
（d）On election of a now member the secretary shall forward to such member a copy of the Rules of the Club．

Any person who shall have rendered sacial service to the Club may, at any general mecting or special general mecting be elcetod a Life Member of the Club with full priviluges.
Honorary Mcmburs may be cicctod by two mambers of the committec for a term not to excoed fourtoon days at any onc time.

## PAYMSNT OF SUBSGRIPTIONS

7 The annual subscription of all membors shall be duc and payablc in advance on August ist in each year. If a member enters after lst Jenuary his subscription for the then remeining portion of the current year shall be pro rata, but in no case shall tho feo paid be less
than £1.1.0.
Any member whose subscription is three months in . arrears shall cease to be a minber of the Club, unless a sufficient explanation be giten to the Comittec. No member shall be eligible to rote on any occasion, or to competo in any match or Club tournament or other competition or be entitled to any privileges of the Club until his subscription is paid.

Any mernber wishing to $r \in s i g n$ rust give a writton notice to the Club's Secretary before the termination of the current year, failing which he will be liable for twelve months subseription.

## POWSR TO EXPEEL

8 The Cominittee may expel fromperbership any member wilfully disobejing any of the Rules or By-laws duly made under those Rulus, or guilty of any conduct rendering him unfit in the opinion of the Cormittee to be a momber of the Club. Provided that before expelling such member the Comrittce shall call upon him for an explanation of his conduct and shall hear what he may wish to urge in his defonce. Any momber expelled in accurdance with this rule shall have no claim on the property of the Club.

## COMMITTTBE MEEEINGS

9 The Comaittee shall meet at least once a quarter and in addition the President or Secretary shall, whenever there shall be any speciel business for the committee, or when requested by two Members of the Committee, coavene a special meeting of the Committee。

## ANNUL GTNERAL MEETING

10 The drnual General Meeting of the Club shall be held each year in the month of sugust, and not later than the 21st of the month, at such time and place as the Committee shall decide. The business of the meeting shall be :-
(a) To receive from the Committee a report and a balance sheet duly audited.
(b) To elect a President, two Vice Presidents, Hon. Treasurer, Hon. General Secretary, Hon. Bowling Secretary, Hona Assistant Secretary, five Members to be the Committee under Rule 5, two suditors, and a

li. The Secretary shall convent a Special General Meeting of the Members of the club at the request of the Committee, or of the President, or of a Vice-President, or upon receiving a written requisition from not less than five members. Such meeting shall $\mathrm{b} \in$ held within 14 days from the time of receiving the request. The Notice of the special general meeting shall clearly set out the business to be submitted, and no other business shall be dealt with.

## NOTICE OF MEETINGS

12. The Secretary shall give to the members at least 7 dey s notice in writing of all annual or special general meetings of tho Club.

## CONDUCT OF GEN RI MEETINGS.

13. (a) at all general moctings of the Club and at all Committee Meetings tho Chairman shall io the President, or in his absence one of the Vico-Presidents, or if none of them be present then some mornbur appointed by the mooting.
(b) At all General Meetings of the Club ton financial mombors shall form a quorum. If within thirty minutes after the hour appointed for holding the mooting there shall bo no quorum present the Chairman shall adjourn the melting for seven days. If at tho adjourned meeting there shall bo no quorum the mooting shall lapse.
(c) No rule of the Clue shall be repealed or altered, ane no new rule shall bu male save by a two thirds majority of financial members and debenture hols Bors presort, and voting at a general mooting. No proposal to repeal, alter, or ald to those Rules shall be considered unless at least five Nay si notice in writing of such proposal shall hare boon given to the Secretary, who shall wow not less than twentyfour hours before the general meeting duliror to ouch member and debenture holder, personally or by post, a copy of such notice.
(a) Subject to these Rules the Committee are ompowersa to mako, ropcal, and amend such $B y-1$ aws as they may from time to time consider noecssary for the well being of the Club, or the control of play on the Clubs greens, which By-laws, repoals and amendments shall have offoct till sot aside by tho Committee or a general meeting.
(0) Every member shall be bound by and submit to the Rules and Bylaws of the Club.
