

With the dry conditions at the start of the year there was talk of delaying the commencement of the season but with the co-operation between the local councils and the clubs we got away on time and the League thanks the councils for their assistance throughout the season.

It was pleasing to see clubs that have been battling over the past few years improving their performances both on and off the field during the year.

Forming sub-committees within the Executive has been successful and involved the members in more actual involvement with running the League, my thanks to the members of the Executive for their assistance.

In my 1982 report I stated that I had every confidence that 1983 would see even better results than in 1982 and I am very pleased that this has happened. The improvement has been mainly due to the strenuous efforts of our office staff, Bruce Holmes and Melanie Farley and on your behalf I thank them.

1983 also saw improvements to our office in Scoresby Road, a new driveway and development of the surroundings. Further activity will take place in 1984, particularly when our neighbour finishes construction of his Sports Centre.

Again thanks to all officials, players and supporters and best wishes for season 1984.

The Executive untiring in their efforts to ensure the smooth operation of the League should be thanked also.


To the Umpires and Tribunal we extend our thanks for unenvied easily criticised job well done.





# **Independent Investigation Tribunal**

The independent tribunal met every Wednesday night at the league headquarters. In that time the tribunal adjudicated on some 333 cases. Of these cases the results were:

261	Guilty	78.38%
46	Not Guilty	13.81%
21	Dismissed	6.31%
Non	Appearance	1.50%

#### Results -

Players were suspended for a total of 639 matches or alternatively 33 years. 35 players were given suspended sentences.

All cases were conducted over a sitting time of 177 hours which averaged 2.35 hours per tribunal.

These gentlemen sit for many hours during the season and most would be aware they are in a most unenviable position of having to sort out the facts from the fiction and to their credit they achieve this.

It's alarming to note that the tribunal had to hear 98 cases more than 1982 and that in itself is concern for us all. Clubs must be prepared to ensure that discipline in their clubs is kept to a premium in order so that we can minimize these reports.

To all our tribunal members on behalf of our league, thanks for job which is often taken for granted.
