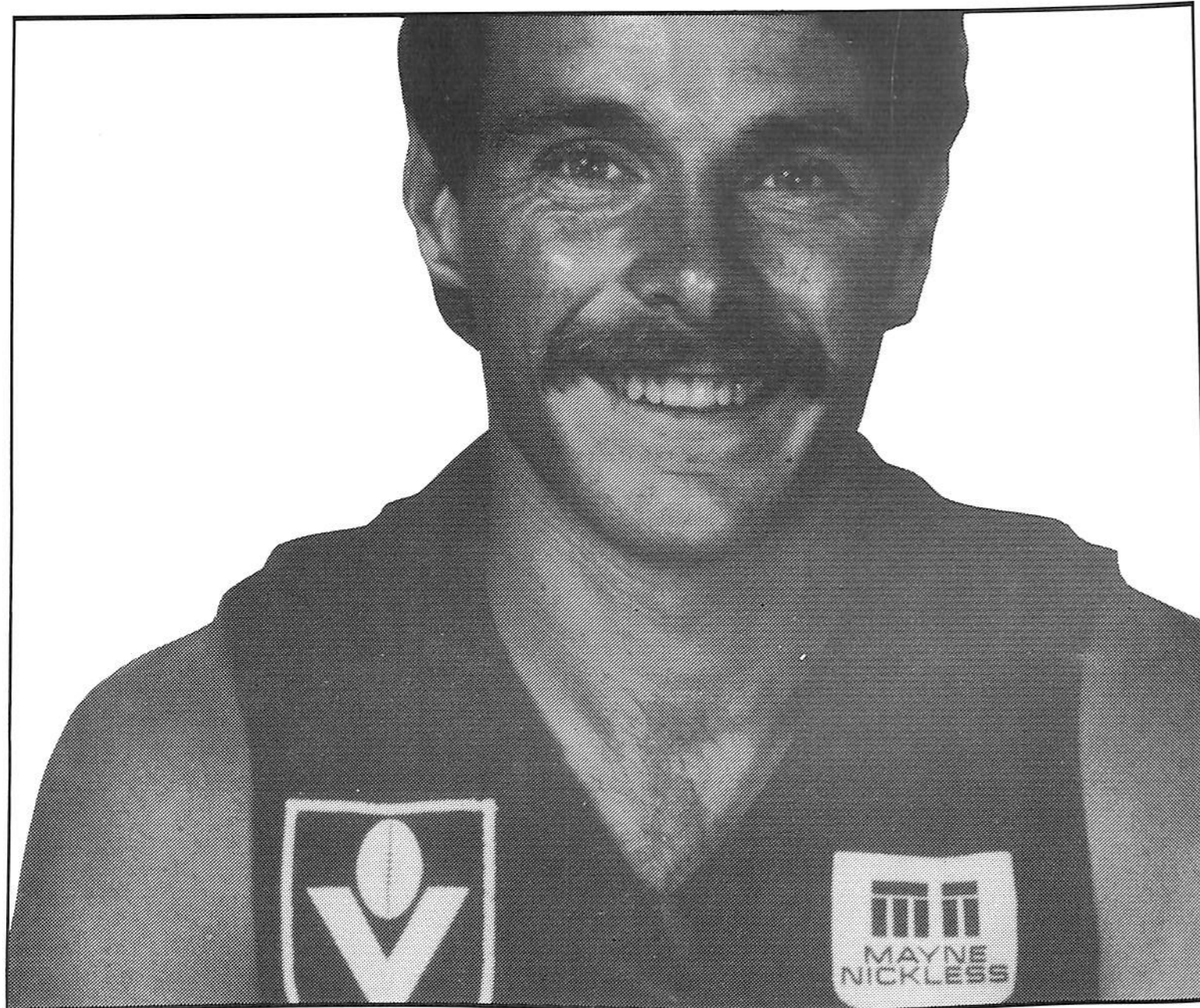

# PRESIDENT'S REPORT

With the 1983 season now over I would like to present some highlights as I saw them.

The terrific success of the Premiership Clubs, Vermont, South Croydon and Warrandyte, not only winning the Senior's flag but having their other sides in the finals as well. Congratulations to these Clubs, they were truly worthy of the Club Champions awards.

A very satisfactory financial position due to a great deal of effort by the Executive, Office Staff and club officials. Unfortunately, some Clubs are having difficulties with their finances and efforts will be made in 1984 to overcome this situation.

Once again the E.D.F.L. team winning the V.M.F.L. Championships Competition thanks to the efforts of the players and others associated with the squad.

The presence of the V.F.L. President, Dr. Alan Aylett, Mrs. Aylett and other V.F.L. and V.M.F.L. officials and their wives at our most impressive Presentation Night, with a special thanks to Mrs. Melanie Farley, our Assistant Secretary, this evening which was so successful.

1983 saw a much closer personal contact between club officials, members of the Executive and office staff, with the result that many queries were solved on the spot before they became major problems.

The growth in the number of our umpires and the continuing high standard of their performance thanks to the Director of Umpiring, Mr. Kevin Collins and members of the Umpires Board.

The increase in firms and organisations offering donations to our League and the continuing generous support from our regular sponsors. Their contributions are of great assistance to the League.

On the debit side, the large number of cases heard by the Tribunal is a cause for concern and it is hoped that the position will improve in 1984. The members of the Tribunal deserve our thanks for the many hours of their time they have given to the League.

Once again the marketing division increased its operations and those clubs who supported this activity deserve our thanks for the financial benefits gained by the League. Efforts will be made to involve all clubs in the marketing in 1984.

Another matter that caused problems in 1983 was the Junior Division, mainly with the Under 16 sides. A continuing effort will be required in this area to solve the difficulties being experienced in some clubs.

With the dry conditions at the start of the year there was talk of delaying the commencement of the season but with the co-operation between the local councils and the clubs we got away on time and the League thanks the councils for their assistance throughout the season.

It was pleasing to see clubs that have been battling over the past few years improving their performances both on and off the field during the year.

Forming sub-committees within the Executive has been successful and involved the members in more actual involvement with running the League, my thanks to the members of the Executive for their assistance.

In my 1982 report I stated that I had every confidence that 1983 would see even better results than in 1982 and I am very pleased that this has happened. The improvement has been mainly due to the strenuous efforts of our office staff, Bruce Holmes and Melanie Farley and on your behalf I thank them.

1983 also saw improvements to our office in Scoresby Road, a new driveway and development of the surroundings. Further activity will take place in 1984, particularly when our neighbour finishes construction of his Sports Centre.

Again thanks to all officials, players and supporters and best wishes for season 1984.

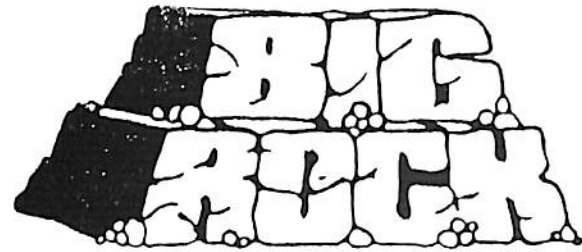

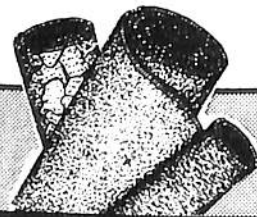

## Independent Investigation Tribunal

The independent tribunal met every Wednesday night at the league headquarters. In that time the tribunal adjudicated on some 333 cases. Of these cases the results were:

261 Guilty	78.38%
46 Not Guilty	13.81%
21 Dismissed	6.31%
Non Appearance	1.50%

### Results -

Players were suspended for a total of 639 matches or alternatively 33 years. 35 players were given suspended sentences.

All cases were conducted over a sitting time of 177 hours which averaged 2.35 hours per tribunal.

These gentlemen sit for many hours during the season and most would be aware they are in a most unenviable position of having to sort out the facts from the fiction and to their credit they achieve this.

It's alarming to note that the tribunal had to hear 98 cases more than 1982 and that in itself is concern for us all. Clubs must be prepared to ensure that discipline in their clubs is kept to a premium in order so that we can minimize these reports.

To all our tribunal members on behalf of our league, thanks for job which is often taken for granted.

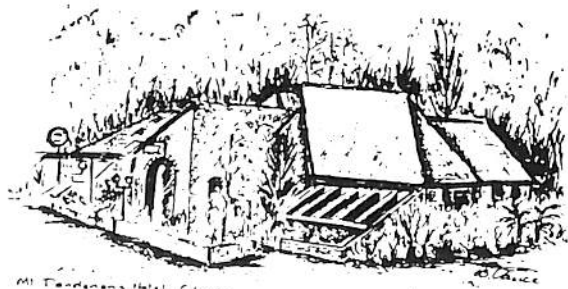

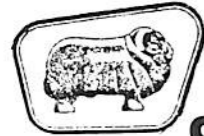
