PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Season 1985 saw another very successful year for the League, with many pleasing events and only a few disappointments.

On the brighter side the financial position of the League continued to improve, mainly due to the record receipts from the finals and a greater profit from our marketing division. The Committee has maintained a strict control over expenditure and we are confident of the Leagues financial future.

While the final series revenue can depend on the clubs taking part and also on the weather the marketing relies on the willingness of clubs to purchase their requirements from the league. In view of this we would expect more clubs to support the marketing division in 1986 and not leave it to some clubs to finance those not assisting the League.

After many years of discussions, meetings and reports it has been resolved that the League aim to increase its membership to forty clubs, with the competition being divided into four divisions, each to consist of ten clubs, with the promotion and relegation system continuing to operate. This will mean a regrading of clubs for 1986 and we will see a much more even competition in each of the four divisions in 1986.

The success of the E.D.F.L. Under 17 Team in winning the 1985 Caltex Cup was a great achievement and full credit to all the players included in the squad, also thanks to the many officials, with a special record of appreciation to our Coach David Quinn. It is hoped we can repeat the performance in 1986 and perhaps inspire the senior squad to take out the Senior V.M.F.L. Championship and so complete the double for the first time.

The 1985 Presentation Night has been voted the best ever according to all reports and a special thanks must be given to Bruce Holmes our Secretary/Manager and Melanie Farley our most capable Assistant Secretary for all the time and effort they spent in organising the evening.

Also my thanks to our very generous patrons and trophy donors for the magnificent support they continue to provide year after year.

Once again we were fortunate to receive full support and co-operation from our local Councils with ground conditions being improved each year. Many clubs have taken advantage of the loans offered by Councils to improve their social rooms and this is greatly appreciated by club members and visitors.

To all those clubs who were successful in 1985 either on or off the field my congratulations. As the standards in this League continue to improve it reflects the efforts made by the clubs to be part of raising this League to even greater heights.

As reported in previous years we have a problem in the junior age groups, particularly with some clubs not being able to field under 18s. The E.D.F.L. is not alone in this and would appreciate any assistance you may care to offer.

Another matter causing concern is the increase in fines, many of which are incurred through sheer carelessness or couldn't care less attitude. This usually occurs in clubs who can least afford this needless expenditure and must be disappointing to club fund raisers and financial supporters.

Finally I would like to thank the many officials of the League who give up so much of their time and at some cost to assist in running the League. A special thank you to Kevin Collins our former Director of Umpiring and Melanie Farley for the work they have done for the League over the years.

Best wishes to all and congratulations to Kevin Pratt M.B.E. on becoming a Life Member of the E.D.F.L.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

There is no doubt that 1985 has been a most outstanding year for the E.D.F.L. Certain decisions taken during the year will create a new era for the Eastern Districts Football League in 1986.

The year commenced amid confusion when the Kilsyth F.C. rejoined the League after three years with the V.F.A. It is unfortunate that such a fine club, with the tradition of Kilsyth, had so much trouble re-adjusting and coming to terms with the disastrous decision taken in 1981 to join the V.F.A., history has proved that. Non-the-less the season commenced with sides in the divisions, comprising 12 in 1st Division, 14 in 2nd Division and 12 in 3rd Division.

I extend my congratulations to all premier teams and of course all individual winners of the various awards and I would be remiss in not extending congratulations to Mr. Kevin Pratt MBE JP who was awarded Life Membership of the E.D.F.L. Kevin's outstanding contribution to the E.D.F.L. was indeed worthy of note and a more deserving recipient is difficult to imagine.

The League has again administered itself with sound management principles and will return a healthy financial situation. It has continued to prosper in a controlled atmosphere and its financial independence is now assured.

The League Executive again decided to participate in the V.F.L. Senior Grade Championships. The Executive were extremely pleased to obtain the services of East Ringwood's Senior Coach, Ray Davies. Ray presented the League with an assault programme for the series and whilst we were unsuccessful in making the final, the plan was successful, it set the path which the League needs to take in order to gain the pinnacle of being the best League in the Metropolitan area.

I extend on behalf of the League, our sincere thanks and appreciation to Ray Davies, his assistant Graeme Weatherley, Chairman of the Squad, Mr. Jim Elmer and of course all the players and officials who gave their time to participate in the Squad. We thank also the East Ringwood F.C. and the Ringwood F.C. for allowing the League to use their facilities.

Our success in the U/17 Caltex Cup was magnificent, the selection of David Quin as Coach started the ball rolling. David presented a working plan also and in this regard was able to produce in the U/17s an attitude built on "the price of success". David's commonsense approach and his understanding of who he was dealing with was the foundation on which we built the strength and success of the side. David was ably assisted by the Runner/Trainer Peter (Spider) Farley whose enthusiasm and dedication was contagious and by Graeme Morgan who has worked valiantly for the squad for the past three years. On behalf of the League I would like to congratulate all those players who participated and the officials who assisted in the preparation from rags to riches, it certainly was a success story founded on team involvement from everyone.

The year again presented problems with the junior areas. It is a massive problem for the League but it is not a problem restricted to the E.D.F.L.

It is something confronting all Leagues and Associations and it is about time that everyone at V.M.F.L. level discussed the issue. However, there is no point in discussing anything unless everybody is prepared to abide by the decisions that come from the meeting but as I say it is a big problem and one that is not easy overcome.

After years of constant thought, consideration and requests by the delegates, the League will regrade into four divisions in 1986 with the First, Second and Third Divisions comprising of ten teams each and the fourth division making up the remainder. It is a momentous decision as it will herald the E.D.F.L. into the 1990s and will ensure the strength and well being of the League for future generations. I'm sure that we will approach the new divisions with confidence and enthusiasm and look forward to a great year in 1986.

I would like to express my thanks and appreciation to my assistant Mrs. Melanie Farley who will terminate her employment with the League on the 13th December. Melanie has been a tower of strength to myself and has made an outstanding contribution to your League. I for one, along with the Executive Committee, recognise the valuable input by Melanie to the League over the years and I can assure you Melanie will be difficult to replace. However, we wish her well with her imminent family and she will always remain close to our hearts. To all clubs, I hope you appreciate this lady who did so much for the League.

I would like to express my thanks to Shelley James who joined us at the beginning of the season. Shelley adapted herself to the intricacies of the football world and performed her duties admirably.

To the Executive Committee, who are honorary, I extend my thanks for your strength and support. Particularly to the President, Mr. Gordon Parker, who was always available to lend assistance and his commonsense attitudes, for without it I'm sure that I could not have achieved what I have.

To all the clubs, officials I thank you for your patience and perseverance and certainly for your support. I trust we will be able to continue that association during 1986.

To our umpires I say thank you for a job well done and in doing so I would like to welcome to the League, Mr. Noel O'Brien our new Director of Umpiring. We wish him well and look forward to an outstanding year with the umpires under his direction. I'm sure it will be a most entertaining year for our umpires.

To Laurie Benoit, Chairman of the Independent Tribunal, and the Tribunal members, I once again extend our thanks to those who perform this thankless and onerous task.

In conclusion, may I say that next year will be a year of change, a year in which we will embark on a new direction and for this new direction to work and operate in accordance with policies it requires your acceptance, dedication and support. The future is in your hands.

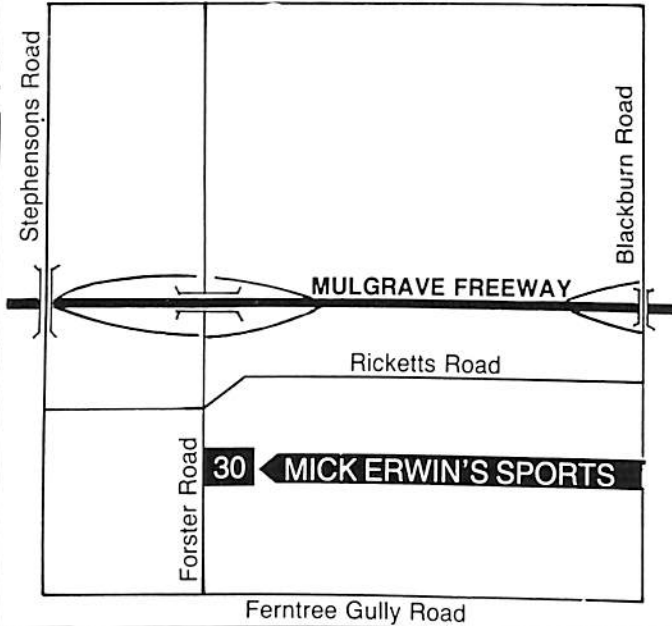

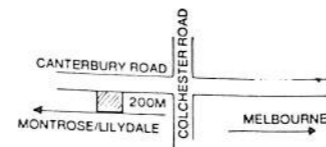
