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

Dear Bruce

I wish to lodge an appeal against the refusal of the Blackburn Football Club to grant my clearance to play with the East Ringwood Football Club in season 1987.

I played for Blackburn in 1986 (playing in 3 reserve games and 8 senior games) resuming after 3 years out of football due to a knee reconstruction. At the time of my injury I was playing for Fitzroy Football Club, Reserves, after being a member of their 1982 U/19 Premiership side. I commenced the rehabilitation process, but became disillinsioned as progress was slow due to infection after surgery. I retired at the end of 1984, leaving my options open at Fitzroy.

My enthusiasm for playing football was rekindled after discussions with friends who were playing at Blackburn ie. 1985 ex coach, assistant coach and some players. It was solely due to their persuasive words that I decided to play again. Although I enjoyed playing those few games with Blackburn my zest for the game wained towards the end of 1986 when I became disillusioned with B.F.C. in general. I had an increasing disrespect for the coach and the overall lack of enthusiasm around the club did not impress me.

In February 1987 I was approached by Adrian Maclure, 1985 senior coach at B.F.C. now coaching Upwey, as to the possibility of playing there in 1987. I declined the offer as it was too far to travel and the standard of competition in my opinion was lower.

At this point I feel that it is necessary to explain that since my knee injury I have always wondered whether I would have been capable of making the senior V.F.L grade. For this reason I have had an ambition to prove that my knee injury is not a hindrance to my football capabilities. I had even considered trying out with VFA Club Port Melbourne as it is close to my place of business, however I feel my form last year would not have warranted any possibility of playing at the V.F.A level.

Although not feeling confident enough to try V.F.A I knew that I wanted to play with a competitive club, therefore I approached East Ringwood. The competitiveness within the club was evident after my first practice match with them, I knew I would have to fight every week for a position in the firsts putting the pressure on me to be fit and improve my skills. I have the ambition to play the highest standard of football that I am capable of and prove to myself how well I could do. My reason for approaching this particular club was that I had ties with the Secretary, the President and many of the players from Fitzroy days.

I reluctantly commenced preseason, late, with Blackburn in 1987, completely disenchanted and disappointed with the re-appointment of the senior and reserves coach, the departure of friends from the club and the general future of B.F.C.

Having my football playing days cut short through injury, not to mention my most recent injury, missing 6 weeks due to a depressed fracture of the checkbone, I feel my future is immediate and I must make the most of the time I have available to play a high standard, challenging game of football.

I feel staying at B.F.C would not be advantageous to my football future if anything it would be harmful.

In brief, the bottom line is East Ringwood Football Club or nowhere, if my clearance is not granted I will not play football for any club. This would create a ludicrous no win situation for myself and Blackburn Football Club. This whole state of affairs is unnecessary within suburban football as it creates anomosity between clubs and players by not allowing them to play where they believe they will be happy and get the most out of the game.

APPEAL RIGHTS OF V.M.F.L. PLAYERS A player of a club of an affiliated body who has had one clearance application to transfer to another affiliated body refused within one season may appeal on the approved form to the Players' Appeals Board of the VMFL against the refusal within seven days of such refused clearance being received by the affiliated body to which the player wishes to transfer. The appeal shall be heard whenever possible, within 14 days of receipt by the VMFL Secretary of written notice of such appeal. The clubs and players concerned shall each be entitled to representation at the hearing, the number of persons having representation to be limited to the player and his advocate who shall also be the club's representative and the defendant club's representative and its advocate. Such representatives shall not be qualified to act as a barrister or solicitor. The closing date for all appeals shall be 1st July in each year, excepting that a player whose second or latest application for a clearance is refused after 1st July, shall be entitled to appeal to the Players' Appeals Board in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution provided such clearance was lodged prior to 1st July. Determination of the commencement of a clearance shall be the date of lodgement with an affiliated body on or prior to 1st July in each year. A deposit of \$100 must be lodged with an appeal together with a player's refused clearance application. Should the appeal be considered frivolous. The defendant club must also lodge a deposit of \$100 at least 48 hours prior to the morning which may be forfeited should the defence be considered frivolous or should the club not be represented at the hearing. Should a player lodge such deposit it will be within the power of the VMFL to grant a clearance to the player concerned.





Dear Gordon,

I am forwarding to you a copy of the video tape of the Mitcham versus East Ringwood game which was made available to East Ringwood on the Sunday after the tribunal hearing of a charge of misconduct against M. Dimitriou of East Ringwood.

Whilst the video tape is segmented it is only presented in this way to show the umpire prior to the alleged incident, during and after the incident, but it is possible to obtain an uncut tape should that be necessary.

This video shows no mud on the umpire prior to and a small amount of mud the size of a 20 cent piece on the left shoulder of the umpire after the incident.

Mud on the umpires back occurred when the umpire backed into a Mitcham player whilst mud on the front of the umpires shorts occurred sometime after the incident.

On viewing the video tape you will see that there was no intent to direct mud at the umpire who was 1½ metres away.

Two members of the E.D.F.L. Executive were in attendance at the match, namely Geoff Orton and Lorraine Day, who may be able to offer their opinions on what they witnessed of the incident.

I personally have recently discussed the incident with Geoff Orton and he has indicated that should he be required he would be prepared to give evidence.

At the time of the tribunal hearing we were not in a position to call witnesses, but on viewing the video tape we are now in a position to know who was in the proximity of the incident and these people have indicated they are available should they be required.

Whilst we are aware that a resolution was passed recently disallowing video evidence at tribunals, but this incident occurred prior to the particular resolution.

We at East Ringwood believe in tribunals and we can accept the decisions of same, providing natural justice has been done.

With respect we believe that with the additional information now available that the case should be re-heard and point out that the rules of the F.D:F.L. were not adhered to in that the word "misconduct" was the only description given on the report sheet. Yet, under the new rules, Section 14.3, states that all details of the incident should have been given on the League's authorised report sheet.

Seventeen year old, Micheal Dimitriou has already served two weeks of his sentence and we respectfully ask that the League give this matter urgent consideration.
