* PETITION RESPECTING SCHOOL SITE AT NORTH SCORESBY.

* The Hon R. Ramsay
Minister of Public Instruction

We the undersigned residents of North Scoresby, beg to bring under your notice that at the last visit of the District Inspector, J. Holland, Esq. when enquiring about sites for a new school, two were placed at the disposal of the Department, one on Mr Cullis' ground and the other on Mr Miller's

We humbly beg to call your attention to the fact that the last named site is too far from the centre of population the majority of children residing to the west of the Building in which the school is now held while the above site is at least half a mile farther to the East where but a few children reside.

We have since obtained the offer of another site on Mr Tillack's ground within a short distance of the present leased building and are of the opinion that this site Especially is the most suitable and is ^{also above} ~~at least~~ 4 miles distant from any other school in the District.

Trusting this will be met with favourable consideration
