ALTERATION TO SCHOOL COUNCIL CONSTITUTION.

Following on our telephone conversation outlining the alternatives available to the School Council in changing the School Council Constitution re length of tenure, which arose from our letter of 2nd July, 1982, the following decision was agreed to at the Annual Meeting of Parents held on 7th July, 1982.

The meeting carried the motions —

- 1. That we seek the approval of the Education Department to alter that part of the Constitution related to length of tenure to persons be elected to the Council for a two year term with half the members retiring each year therefore annual elections.
- 2. That elections be held in June of each year.
- That the term of the existing Council be extended from December, 1982 till June, 1983.

The third request was considered desirable in view of the staff changes that will take place in 1983, when a new Principal and senior staff will

take up new appointments at the school. By extending the term of the present Councillors to June, 1983, it was felt that continuity would be achieved.

The School Council of Southwood P.S., feel the present term of office Q yrs is too long, and the present system of all positions being vacated does not permit continuity of School Councillor As a result, a Public Meeting of parents was called and the following resolutions were passed unanimously.

- 1. Each elected Councillor, having been elected for a three (3) year term, such terms to be staggered a that half the elected members retire each eighteen months.
- 2. All positions of Office Bearers is the Council be declared vacant each eighteen months, coincident with Council Elections.
- Representatives (being three parents and two teachers) commence in January and the other half (being four parents and one teacher) commence in July.
- 4. The Council taking office in January, 1983, be elected so that four parent representatives and

one teacher representative, serve until the end of June, 1984. The School Council seeks your approval for this alteration to the Constitution of the Council prior to the elections due to be held in December this year for the new Council term commencing January, 1983.
