Dear Alan,

I have recently had correspondence with the Lutheran Church Archives & Research Centre re my family history. As some branches of my line had the Wie spelling to their surname the Centre has sent me photocopies of their letters to you dated 7th Feb.,18th July and the 13th Nov.1989. So I contact you to see if we could perhaps be of some help to each others research.

Firstly the Rose Ann and Annie Therese Weiland daughters of Charles from Bendigo mentioned in the letter dated 13th Nov. 1989 are members of my family line so if further information is helpful please contact.

There was a branch of my line living in and around Taradale, Vic. which were noted on some records as using the spelling WIELAND. Eg The Bailliere's Post Office Directories of 1868 & 1869 showing

1. Charles Wieland, Carpenter of Golden Point.

2. Charles Wieland, Miner of Chewton.

  3. Fredrick Wieland, Miller of Lancefield.
  4. Frederick Wieland, Miner of Taradale.

The Lancefield Cemetery has a Henry John Wieland, died 8th December buried 9th December 1882, aged 1 year a farmers son from Emu Flats. Possibly the son of #3. above.

The Victorian Electoral Roll of 1856 has a Gottlieb Wieland, Carter, Backcreek, Boroondara, freehold house and land in the Templestowe Division. From Lutheran records there is a Baptismal record for Mathilde Maria Wieland, born 7.4.1856 at Boroondara, Bapt.16.6.1856. Parents Gottfried Benjamin Wieland & Johanna Charlotte Tassler. Also a marriage of a Henriette Auguste Wieland, 18 yrs. parents as previous, to Carl August Kilian 7.6.1865. While there is a difference in the first name spelling Gottlieb /Gottfried it would appear the same family.

The Box Hill Cemetery has a number of Wieland's/Weiland's Carl F. Weiland, 74 of Ringwood, Buried 14.1.1902 - Meth.401 Nth. Caroline Wieland, of Bayswater, 20.3.1904 - Meth.401 Nth. Sarah Wieland, 25 of Ringwood, 13.6.1907 - Meth.401 Sth. Lislie Wieland, 13 days of Ringwood, 11.12.1905 - Meth.401 Nth. Daign Flair Wieland, 4.1/2 Tthe of Discount 14.1.1012 M. 401 Sth. Daisy Elsie Wieland, 4 1/2 mths. of Ringwood, 14.1.1913 M.401 Sth.
