Incorporation of design influences

The intent of the Guidelines is to incorporate these design influences into new public domain elements such that there is a tangible representation of them within the streetscapes and parks of the Ringwood Transit City. Specifically, the Guidelines draw on:

- The natural environment, through greater use of indigenous street trees and other plants, and through the use of natural timber finishes to some furniture items.
- The human history, through the use of metal finishes to recall the mining history, and potentially through the influences of Ringwood's indigenous past in the design of one or more of the key public spaces in future.

In terms of colours, finishes and motifs, the approach of the Guidelines is to highlight inherent characteristics of materials and elements rather than applying motifs and colours to them. Examples include using the colours present in the foliage and bark of trees, flowers and shrubs and the natural timber and stainless steel finishes of some street furniture elements.

The design of other elements, and the colour finishes applied to such elements as bins and planter boxes, is more muted, with the intention that these elements are coordinated yet at the same time visually-recessive, allowing the key features and activities of the public domain to provide the prevailing image of the Ringwood Transit City.


1.4 Public domain design principles







