HISTORY OF THE SCHOOL

The history of the school shows that it was originally advertised as the Mitcham Technical School for boys in June 1957 for occupancy in the following year. In 1958 the new school, consisting of 91 boys and a staff of five (5) commenced and was temporarily housed at Ferntree Gully Technical School.

In the following year, the new school was transferred as a whole to an unused section of the Lilydale State School. Difficulties arose in obtaining local land at Mitcham which led to the purchase of a number of acres in Heathmont, between Heathmont Road and Great Ryrie Street. This land was owned by the Bamford family who had lived in the district for three generations. In 1958 the North Box Hill Co-Ed Technical School was advertised, but only the girls' section of the new experiment in technical education could be formed. So in 1959, approximately 60 girls and their teachers were housed at the Box Hill Girls Technical School.

Further difficulties in establishing the North Box Hill Technical School led to the decision of creating a coeducational Technical School for the Ringwood/Heathmont District and thus these girls and also the boys in temporary accommodation at Lilydale, formed the nucleus of the Ringwood Technical School.

Plans were laid for the erection of a single storey, light timber construction building with provision for four wings. This was the first co-educational technical school design evolved by the then Education Department. In February, 1960, both the boys and girls met for the first time, when they occupied the building. This then unusual but pleasant and well run school, soon became a showplace for overseas visitors and Australian educationalists.

A ceremony to mark the official opening of the school was conducted on Friday, 29th September, 1961, by then Minister of Education, the Honourable J.S. Bloomfield M.L.A.

The present Principal is the school's fifth since 1958. The names of these people and their terms as Principal are as follows:—

1958 — 1961 G.M. Veitch

1962 — 1974 E.J. Heard

1974 — 1977 J.F. Haig

1977 — 1988 B.K. Knox

1989 — current W.F. Sheridan

On Saturday, 12th November, 1988, the school celebrated its 30th anniversary. This celebration took the form of an "Open Day" in which all were invited to come back to Ringwood Technical School, relive the memories and wander through the school itself. Some 350 persons attended.

During 1989 Government Legislation was introduced which meant that all schools were to become Secondary Colleges on 1st February, 1990, and that schools would no longer have "Technical" or "High" as part of their name.

With Ringwood Technical and Ringwood High Schools in the same area, it was necessary that one school completely change its name. The School Council carried out extensive consultation with its community and decided to call the school "EASTERN SECONDARY COLLEGE."

Today's ceremony is to recognise this significant occasion which heralds the start of a new era for this school.
