

Rinawood is part of the Country of Mornington. It was once part of the Lilydale Shire, but on the 24th of October 1924 it was created a borough, and proclaimed as such on the 13th December of the same year. It was on the 19th March 1960 that it attained City status.

Ringwood is an important rail junction, to the east the line extends to Healesville, and to the south east to Belgrave.

The City covers an area of 2,276 square kilometres, and has a population of approximately 36,900.

It is set in picturesque country, and is well suited to the residential area it has become. Water and sewerage are provided by Melbourne and Metropolitan Board of Works and electricity by the State Electricity Commission of Victoria. The telephone service is automatic. The highest priority of the Council is the construction of private roads, they hope in the near future to provide this amenity to all residents.

Ringwood is lucky to have approximately 500 acres of parks and recreational reserves, including a beautiful artificial lake, and a croquet lawn. There are adequate, up-to-date shopping centres too. Cultural activities have not been forgotten, in fact the city is flourishing in every way.

On the northern side of the Maroondah Highway is Ringwood Lake Park, a recreational area, where gas barbecues are provided and parking space is more than adequate. For Ringwood nature lovers, Wombolano Park's 25 acres of natural bushland, shows the spendour of Australia's flora and fauna. There is a picnic area and a playground for the kiddies too.

For the active, apart from the many clubs and organisations, there is an 18 hole golf course. It was formerly the municipal tip, but in March 1974 the first nine holes were opened, and the remaining nine were opened in June 1976

Two festivals are held in Ringwood, the Ringwood Highland Carnival and Ringwood Day. The Highland Carnival is held at Jubilee Park and is a display by the Scottish Communities of the metropolitan area. Activities include Highland dancing and displays by pipe bands, Ringwood Day is a change from Youth Day, which was held until March 1977. Ringwood Day is a family/fun day, with a range of activities and displays for all members of the

SMALL CLAIMS TRIBUNAL

A Small Claims Tribunal resolves disputes not more than two years old and involving not more than \$1,000.

If a consumer considers he has a claim against a trader, he can lodge a claim with the Registrar of the Small Claims Tribunal for a fee of \$3. Then the Registrar will arrange a time and place for the hearing and advise both parties of this. Normally both parties attend the hearing in person and conduct their own cases. Therefore the proceedings before a Tribunal involve three people - the Referee, the consumer and the trader. Witnesses are allowed, but no costs are allowed

The Referee will endeavour to negotiate and settle the claim: if this cannot be achieved the Referee will hear both sides of the case and then make an order. which is final and binding. No appeals are allowed, 35 Spring Street, Melbourne, 651 3911.

WELLINGTON HOUSE YOUTH CENTRE

"Wellington House aims to be a centre for young people. Here they can come to talk over their ideas about school, parents and todays world without being

pressured into a particular attitude or form of behaviour. It is a place where they can find out who they are and what they want to achieve with their lives.

Wellington House is situated close to St. Kilda Junction, near Windsor Railway Station, and so is readily accessible from all parts of Melbourne. The building is a spacious old two storey home with large rooms. It has one section where there are games billiards, table tennis and board games. Here young people are free to come to enjoy themselves as they wish. The young people are encouraged to take a lead in organising their club in their own way. Later we hope that activities may extend to sport, swimming and camping.

The other section has rooms where trained professionals - a psychiatrist, a psychologist, social workers and welfare officers are available to listen to young people and their families, to help them define their problems and to discover new ways to handle the difficulties of growing up.

We hope that Wellington House will be a friendly place with a good feeling where people will enjoy coming. They will only be seen if they choose to come of their own free will. It will not be our task to compel anyone against their wishes but we will be happy to see anyone, whatever their circumstances, if they like to consult us.

In the future when our full staff has been appointed we hope to have seminars for those who are concerned with young people - parents, teachers and club leaders. We look forward to sharing experience in discussions and groups so that we can learn from one another. Maybe from those who come will be future leaders who will take part in youth training courses learning how best to work with young people.

At present Wellington House is open from Monday to Friday from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. and on Tuesday and Thursday evenings. The staff consists of Dr. Richard Griffiths, Psychologist Philip Badger and receptionists Jan Martino and Libby Higgs.

However, within the first three months of 1977 we hope to increase the staff by two social workers and two welfare officers. We then plan to extend our services and open in the evenings.

We are pleased to see anyone who cares to 'drop in' or who is referred by his doctor, social worker or teacher. We will try to see anyone who comes but we are busy and it is helpful if you will first phone (51 1502 0 Eff (51 1592 or 51 1593), so that we can be free to spend time with you.

MAROONDAH SOCIAL HEALTH CENTRE

The Centre was established in 1973, with the aim of providing a facility for psychosocial problems of the citizens of Ringwood and Croydon, two of the Outer eastern Melbourne suburbs which have developed extensively in the past decade. Additionally, it was intended to provide preventive health education, and socio-medical research.

It was developed initially through the support of local churches and interested citizens, and was a very modest undertaking, operating in a small villa residence in Patterson Street, East Ringwood. Late in 1974, it became part of the Australian Government's Community Health Programme, and the additional funds then available provided the impetus for expansion of services and of staff and premises. The Committee took the bold step of purchasing tow ad-Joining properties, which became available, thereby Providing increased accommodation and development Potential.

The past year has been one of consolidation and of limited expansion to meet the ever increasing demands upon its counselling and therapy services, provided through a true multi-disciplinary team, ably backed and supported by a force of voluntary workers. The range of services provided to deal with a wide range of personal, family, and social problems is increased by other organisations providing regional facilities through the Centre; these include the Yooralla Society, Adult Deaf Society, and "Addcare" (counselling in alcohol and drug dependency).

Preventive health education programmes are being made available to local general practitioners, ministers, Youth and welfare workers, school teachers, and to lay workers. Talks and films are provided for community groups, and a resource centre, offering books and audio-visual facilities covering human relationship subjects was made possible by Australian Assistance Plan funding.

A Student Unit provides in-service training for University Students in social work and counselling. whilst occupational therapy, physiotherapy, medical and nursing students experience a wide range of practical work in the many programmes which the Centre conducts for various groups.

The financial support provided by the Federal and State Government agencies is supplemented from other services, and the Centre is very dependant upon the generous support of donors in the private sector, and on grants from local Government, Trusts and Foundations, and other private funding bodies; the continued consolidation and of what development is recognized as an essential supportive health care system for the citizens of Ringwood and Croydon, as well as a model for many other areas, will depend on the extent to which essential financial support is forthcoming. The Centre is now encorporated under the Hospitals and Charities Act (1928).

Volunteers refer those needing professional help to appropriate agencies, provide information on a wide variety of topics for those who ask for this, listen to those who need a "listening ear' for often people can feel that no-one has the time to listen anymore. R.C.A.S. also co-operate with other organisations helping people in need. Funding

The administration and day-to-day running of a voluntary service of this magnitude, requires a considerable degree of commitment on the part of its members. Ringwood and Croydon Councils have provided accommodation and telephones, and some of the telephone expenses. The service is then dependent on subscriptions and donations from other community organisations, which support their work.

An "Access" grant in 1975 enabled publicity to be distributed more widely, and also contributed to the on-going cost of updating and gathering of directory information.

The communication of ideas, emotions and information is the most important aspect of living . . . and the Citizen's Advice Bureaux workers are daily conscious of the fact.

R.C.A.S. began in 1967 as the Ringwood Citizens' Advisory Service, being one of the first suburban C.A.B.'s in Melbourne; early in 1975 the Service expanded into the Croydon area and became the Ringwood Croydon Advisory Service.

R.C.A.S. is a member of the Victorian Association of Citizens Advice Bureaux; and other Citizens' Advice Bureaux are listed in the telephone directory under this title.

C.A.B.'s are store-houses of information in the community: Government, semi-government, professional and voluntary agencies, information about people and groups in your area.

R.C.A.S. always welcomes news and information about new groups and organisations, change of aims office bearers and so on.
