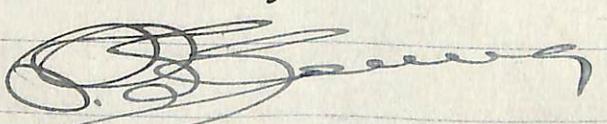

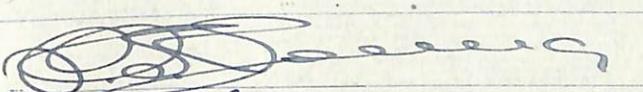

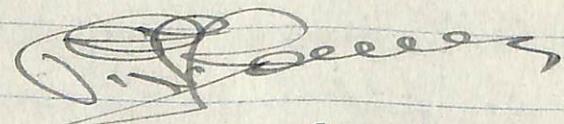

Owing to higher Running Costs your Committee finds it necessary to increase the Space Rent for the year 1921-1922 to 1/7 per case. The increase of 1d per case-space over last year is due to our Engineers coming under a determination of the Factory Engine Drivers' Board and also to increased interest and Sinking Fund instalment payable on the cost of the installation of the new Engine.

In order to meet the large number of Applications on hand for Shares and to reduce Running Costs to a minimum your Committee has decided that from the commencement of 1922 in the Lower Store (Chambers 7 to 12 inclusive) cases are to be stacked seven high in lieu of six as at present.
