


Let's find out more about these insects.




There are over 2000 kinds of mosquitoes found all over the world—even Alaska.



The larvae stays frozen all winter.




Not with their jaws but with sharp needle like points




The saliva the mosquito injects makes the bite itchy.

After 3-5 days the pupa rest on the water surface ready for the last stage of the cycle.

The back breaks open and out comes the mosquito's head and front legs.



While the front legs rest on the water surface for a minute, the wings dry and stiffen.




Donkeys like carrots and apples.



It would be unkind no to have a shed in the paddock for your donkey. Why is this?





People found out thousands of years ago that donkeys made good pack animalsso, through the ages these sturdy little animals have been used to carry loads and people from place to place.




Have you ever thought of keeping a guinea pig? It makes a good pet for children because it does not scratch or bite.

Don't keep any more than one male, or they will fight each other over the females.


Give your guinea pigs something to make their nest from. Straw is good. The babies will eat solid food in the second day, but the mother will still feed them milk for a fortnight.
