- I wish to draw your attention to the fact that the 5. concessions granted to Cool Stores add to the financial difficulties of the State, and to request therefore that immediate and earnest consideration be given to the question of arranging the finances of your Society, to insure prompt payment of its future commitments to the Treasury.
