

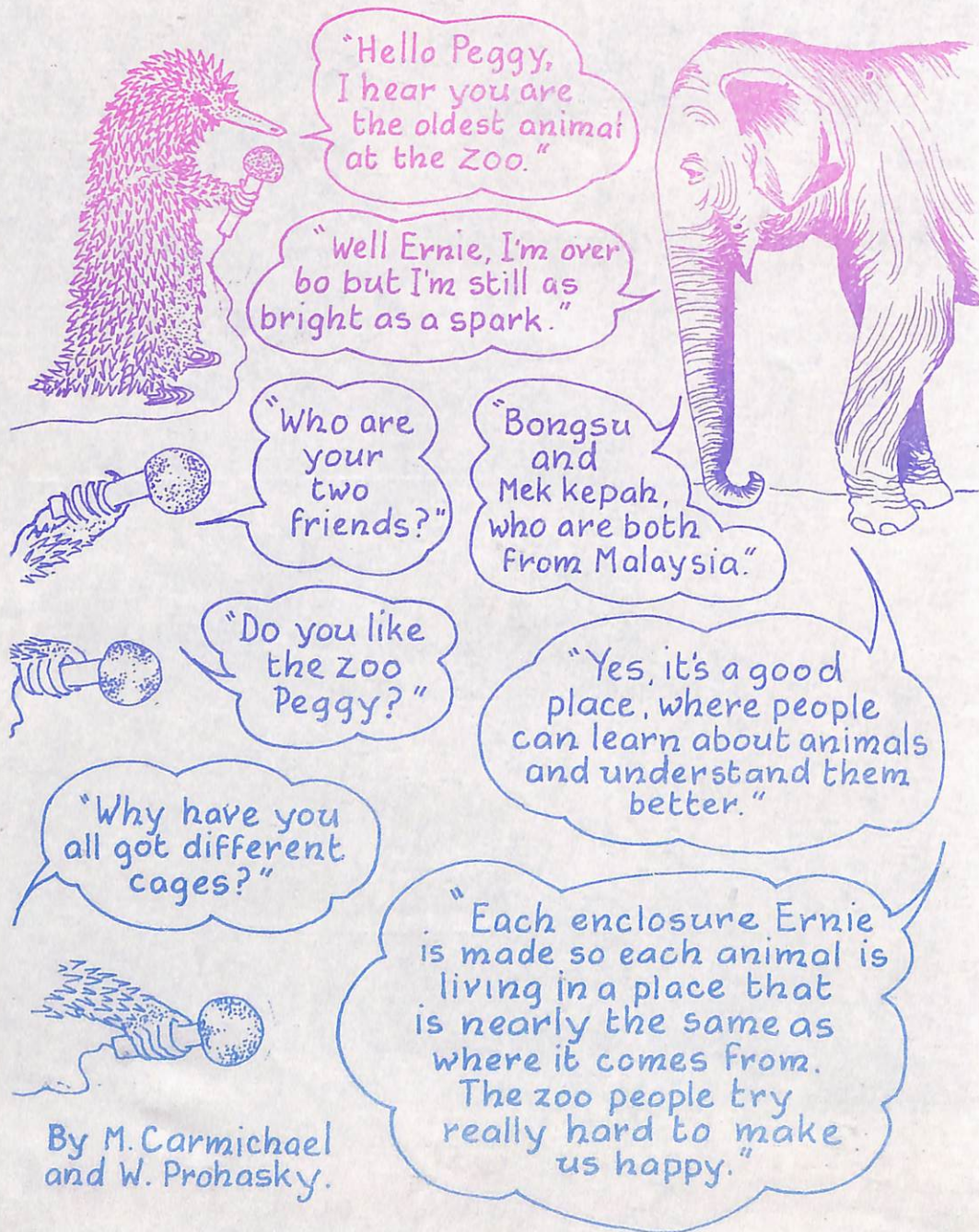

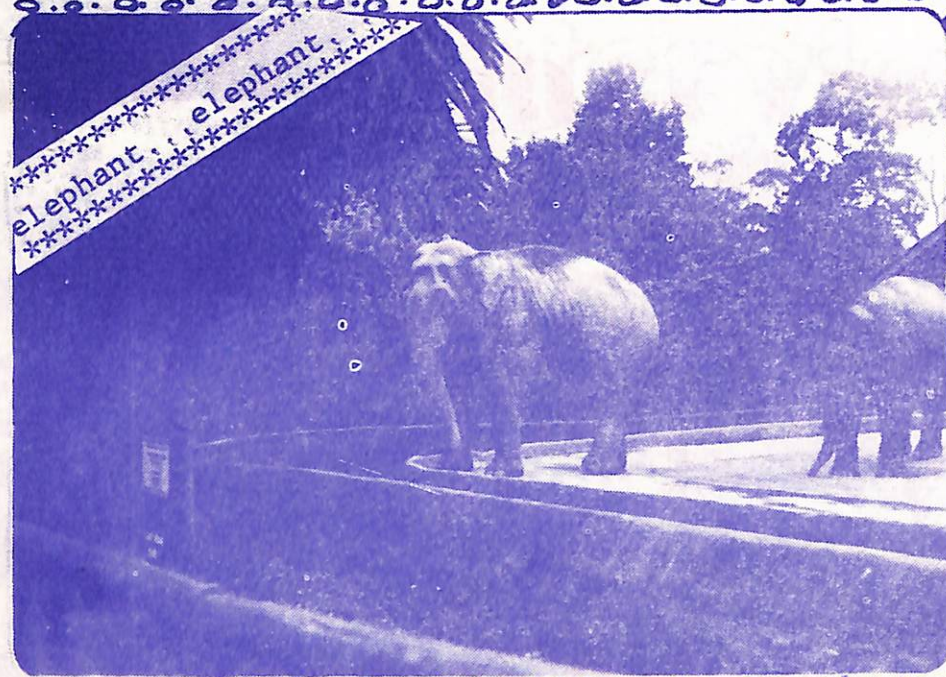

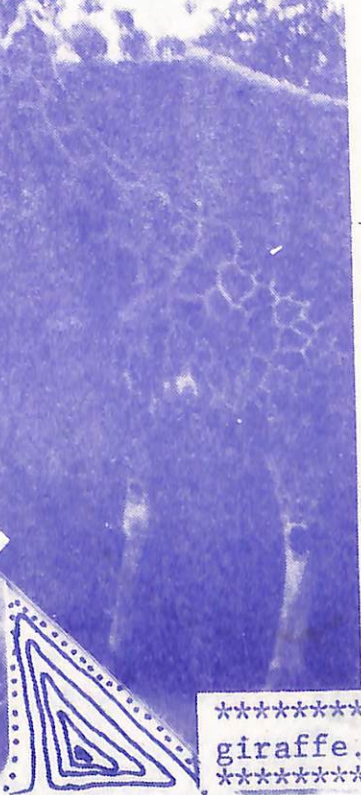

60 Kg MEAT



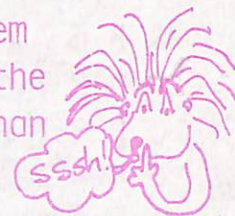
The vet looks after any sick animals. He has to operate sometimes if the animal gets really sick.

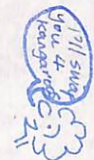
The newest animal at the zoo is a tiger from a zoo in Germany.
