





Based on characters created by Damon Runyon and compiled by Frank Loesser, Guys & Dolls is a story about gambling, the fast life, guys, dolls and love.


Nathan Detroit has been successfully running his floating crap game for years now, but just when all the big gamblers are in town he cannot find a place as the FBI is breathing down everyone's neck. Nathan's only chance is the Biltmoore Garage, but he needs a \$1,000 Cash, and in advance. To make things worse for Nathan, it's his 14th Anniversary with his fiance Adelaide, the famous Broadway star - and he doesn't even have enough money to buy her a present. Nathan decides to bet Sky Masterson - the highest and most respected gambler of them all, \$1000 that he cannot take any girl Nathan names to Havana, Cuba for dinner tomorrow night. Sky accepts and Nathan chooses Sergeant Sarah Brown, leader of the local Salvation Army.

Sky, using the fact that the mission is in serious need of customers, swindles Sarah into going with him. Nathan not having the \$1,000 decides to hold the crap game in the mission during Sarah's absence, but they are discovered when Sarah and Sky return from Havana. In Havana they had fallen in love, but now Sarah is convinced that she has been used so as to leave the mission empty.

The crap game has resumed in one of the city sewers and things are getting nasty for Nathan when Sky arrives. To make it up to Sarah, he bets each gambler a \$1,000 against their souls - if he loses he pays each a \$1,000, if he wins they all have to turn up to the mission.

A few hours later they're all seated in the mission, even Nathan who has missed his elopement with Adelaide so as to be there. Sky leaves for points west and all looks bad. But surprise, surprise the mission gets saved, Sky returns and the girls triumph with marriage.
