

The Story of Grease

Grease was devised in the early seventies at the height of the disco era and was a throwback to a simpler time when boys drove fast cars and girls didn't. It was written by two 50's muso's who grew up in that era and realised that Broadway needed to be reminded of the time that spawned the Rock and Roll revolution. Broadway answered the authors , Jim Jacobs and Warren Casy , with an astounding 2179 performances which put it in the same league as "Fiddler on the Roof", "My Fair Lady" and "Hello Dolly". It tells the story of the T-Birds, whose leader Danny, in the tradition of all 50's male idols, falls for the squeaky clean Sandy, who is trying to change her image and join the Pink Ladies. The story is highlighted by many marvellous songs in the tradition of the era, showing off the styles of the time - doo wop, all-girl groups, and straight rock 'n roll. After its successful run on Broadway, the show was transferred to the big screen in 1978, making even bigger stars of Olivia Newton-John and John Travolta. Grease is one of the most popular musicals of recent times, and in amongst the gloom and doom of today, we are sure you will leave the theatre with your toes tapping and a smile on your face.

The Principal Cast

Danny - Steven Gates

Steve returns to the Fabulous Nobodys, having last appeared with us in the role of Frederic in "The Pirates Of Penzance". Since that time, he has held the role of 'Leading Player' in "Pippin" with WLOC, the Dentist in "The Little Shop Of Horrors" and in Stagestruck's "Working" as a Construction Worker. Steve's first role was as a singing minstrel in WLOC's "Robin Hood", and he was most recently involved with the concert produced by "Eight is Enough" in January. If this was the year 1959, Steve believes he would be selling Tupperware door to door whilst being scared of the Russians.





Sandy - Keli Sutherland

Keli has never appeared with the Nobodys, but she is no stranger to the stage, having had the role of 'Leisl' in "The Sound of Music" with Paragon United Artists in 1993. It was for this role that she was nominated for the Paragon Annual Awards in the categories of Best Actress and Most Promising Talent. Aside from this, she has appeared in lead roles in her school productions of "Godspell" and "HMS Pinafore". She is currently studying Applied Science at Swinburne, and believes that, in the year 1959, she would probably have been a mechanic!


The Pink Ladies and The T - Birds

Jan - Melinda Gregory

Melinda joins the Nobodys for the first time, but she comes with a lot of experience behind her. She has appeared in Stagestruck's "Working" as the check-out chick and waitress, and in "Company" as Sarah. She also has experience with Ranges Music Theatre and Phoenix Music Club, and sings in the group 'Les Ms' - a female acapella group which performs around Melbourne. She will soon record a C.D. and has appeared on "Good Morning Australia". In the fifties, Melinda would have held down the job of a roller-skating waitress.



Kenickie - Marco Zeilinger

Marco has performed for Ranges and played the role of 'Conrad Birdie' in "Bye Bye Birdie", and 'Charlie Davenport' in their production of "Annie Get Your Gun". It was this performance which earned him a nomination at the recent Lyrebird Theatre Awards. Using his extensive imagination, Marco believes that in the year 1959, he would be somebody who "does amatuer theatre and tries to figure out what to do with their life"!




Doody - Joey Alcock

Heather Hayes

Heather has previously appeared with the Nobodys as one of the Shark girls in "West Side Story", and with Ranges Music Theatre in "Annie Get Your Gun". She's otherwise been dancing, singing and doing anything creative, and would have owned a restaurant if this was the year 1959.

Leanne Callegaro

Leanne has previously had the roles of Consuelo (the tart) in "West Side Story", Ermenguarde (the sook) in "Hello Dolly" and has appeared in the chorus of shows including "Oliver", "The Boyfriend", "Music Man" and "My Fair Lady". If this was the year 1959, Leanne would have been a rollerskating waitress, movie star and a cheerleader all in one!

Lindsey Richardson

This is Lindsey's first Australian production, but she is a regular to the stage at home in America. While studying at Radcliffe, Harvard, she has appeared in "Love's Labors Lost", "Sweeny Todd", "The Devil's Disciple"and "Oklahoma". She's a 21 year old Social Anthropology student, who would have been a waitress on wheels at the local 'Sonic'.



Julia Sutherland

Although Julia would have been a waitress on the Boulevard of Broken Dreams in the fifties, in this life she's a Science student. Julia has had the lead role in her school production of "The Crucible", appeared as a dancer in "Godspell" and was a finalist in the Victorian Talent Quest of 1992.

Rachel Pollard

By now Rachel is a regular with the Nobodys, having appeared in our productions of "Pirates of Penzance", "My Fair Lady" and "West Side Story", often being featured as a dancer - a role she also believes she would have held in the fifties.

Janet Carroll

Janet is a veritable veteran of the stage at the ripe old age of 20! She has appeared in most of the Nobodys productions, as well as "Guys & Dolls" with BUSTCO and in plays with Lilydale Athenaeum and Box Hill Theatre Group.

Naomi Deans

Since she is studying at the Dance Factory, Naomi would have been a dancer on the 'Big Band Show' in the fifties. She has appeared in various school shows and performed the lead role in "The King & I".



Danielle Biggs

Danielle's past performances include having been a Shark girl in "West Side Story"with the Nobodys last year. She has also played 'Mimi' in "Guys & Dolls" and 'Mrs Dai Bread Two' in "Under Milk Wood" with Maroondah Theatre.

Suzy Lovass

Suzy believes she would have put her dance skill to use and been a roller skating waitress in the fifties, rather than a nurse in the nineties. As well as choreographing, Suzy has appeared in two Nobodys and many Whitefriars productions.

Bianca Zubevich (Cha Cha)

Bianca would still have been a doctor, were this the fifties although her patients would have had to be within the radius of the chain holding her to the kitchen sink! She has previously appeared in Monash Players' "After Dinner" and "A Funny Thing Happened on the way to the Forum".

Janet Vandenbergen (Patty Simcox)

Janet has appeared in "Guys & Dolls", "The Mikado" and "Grease" with her school productions, as well as playing a Jet Girl with the Nobodys production of "West Side Story". She would have been a waitress in the fifties.

Anthony Woodcock


Anthony has been with the Nobodys since "Pirates Of Penzance", and most recently played the part of 'Bernardo' in "West Side Story". His hobbies include dancing and acrobatics and attempting to cultivate S.N.A.G. attitudes, but believes he would have been a singing and dancing crazy cook in the year 1959.

Seaton Allen

Seaton has appeared in "West Side Story" as a Jet and in the role of 'Nathan Detroit' with Maroondah's "Guys & Dolls". Since Seaton is a big cricket supporter, he would have been David Boon's father and mentor in the fifties.

Peter last appeared on stage as Chino in "West Side Story" where, for once, he totally missed out in getting the girl!! He has acted extensively with Knox, Mitcham and Calyton Theatre Groups and would have been Eddie from Eddie and the Cruisers (which would mean that he would be dead!) or a mechanic in 1959.




Andrew Phillips

David Spencer-Gardner (Tom)



Frazer Yendell



Mrs Lynch / Viola - Tracey Davidson





Coach Calhoun - Ron Mitzi





The Fabulous Nododys Theatre Co was born in the second half of 1990 when Tony Bird and Richard Van't Riet decided to form a company which would be totally professional in it's attitude towards and staging of productions but would always remain purely amateur in its status.
