Dear Sir,

I have been directed by my Commissioners to inform you that recent investigation disclosed that your Council and certain property owners at Ringwood are pouring drainage and sewage into the railway drain, colored red on the attached plan, without the authority of this Department.

In order to assist your Council and its ratepayers to effectively dispose of such drainage and sewage, my Commissioners are prepared to permit the railway drain to be so used on condition that your Council agrees to execute this Department's standard form of drainage licence which would include provision for -

- (1) The payment of a licence fee of 5/- on 1st July in each year;
- (2) The maintenance and cleansing of the drains colored red and green respectively, by your Council at its cost and to the satisfaction of this Department;
- (3) The cleansing of the culvert under the railway by this Department at the cost of your Council.

Upon receipt of your Council's written acceptance of the foregoing conditions, suitable instructions will be issued to the staff concerned.
