Charles Ernest Carter and Olive Maud Ballard were married at Christ Church Whittlesea on 13th September 1902.

One hundred years later, the descendants of the marriage gathered at Christ Church Whittlesea on 15th September 2002 to celebrate the centenary of the marriage.

These notes are designed to give a brief overview of the families, their ancestries and the life and times of C.E. and O.M. Carter.

The Ancestors of Charles Ernest Carter

Charles Ernest Carter was the second child (and second son) of **Henry Carter** and **Caroline Eliza Carter (nee Schofield)**.

Henry Carter was born in Liverpool, England, in 1851, the son of William Carter (b. 1808) and Jane Carter (nee Knowles).

Henry Carter came to Australia in about 1871.

Caroline Eliza Schofield was born in Emerald Hill (South Melbourne) in 1856, the daughter of **William Schofield** and **Caroline Schofield (nee Cotton)** who married on 30 August 1852.

That marriage took place at the Church in the Parish of Bromley, St. Leonard in the County of Middlesex, England. **William Schofield** was noted as being a widower, with the occupation of Mariner. His father, also **William Schofield**, was, by occupation, a Weaver.

Caroline Cotton was shown as being a spinster, the daughter of **John Cotton** (deceased). The residence at time of marriage of bride and groom was given, for both, as 22 Randall Street (town not given).

Caroline Eliza Schofield was thus the first Australian born ancestor of the descendants of Charles Ernest Carter and, as will be detailed shortly, of Olive Maud Ballard.

William Schofield's father was also **William Schofield**. No other details are known. **Caroline Cotton's** parents were **John Cotton** (birth date unknown) and **Mary Cotton (nee Barnes)** who was born on 24 March 1782. They married in 1808. No earlier ancestry is known.

The Birth of Charles Ernest Carter

The Extract of Births for 1878 in the Colony of Victoria shows that **Charles Ernest Carter** was born in Bowen Street, Borough of Footscray, County of Bourke on 7th February 1878, the son of **Henry Carter**, carpenter, 27 years, born in Liverpool, England and **Caroline Eliza Carter**, maiden name Schofield, 21 years, born in Emerald Hill, Victoria.

The Certificate notes that Henry and Caroline were married on 7th August 1875 and there was already one child of the marriage, **William Henry Carter**.

Charles Ernest Carter was in fact the second of 10 children to **Henry Carter** and **Caroline Eliza Carter (nee Schofield)**. The children were:

Note there was a child born every second year from 1876 to 1894. All children were born in Footscray except for Frederick who was born in Ascot Vale (hence his middle name).

Charles Ernest Carter's birthplace was noted as Bowen Street, Footscray. No Bowen Street is shown in Footscray in modern street directories. However early Collins Street directories refer to Byron Street, Footscray as "including the continuation thereof shown on map as Bowen Street".

It could be thus deduced that **C.E. Carter** was born in what is now generally known as Byron Street, Footscray on 7th February 1878.

The Probate parchment of **William Schofield**, the father of **Caroline Eliza Schofield** (and thus **Charles Ernest Carter's** grandfather) shows **William Schofield** to be "late of number 5 Byron Street, Footscray in Victoria, Mariner deceased, who died on the fifth day of May 1883".

It is therefore most likely that **Charles Ernest Carter** was born in the family home of his mother at 5 Byron Street, Footscray.

The Life & Times of Charles Ernest Carter

C.E. Carter's childhood was spent in and around Footscray. He attended Footscray State School, graduating in 1891 at the age of 13. Early occupations included the property business, selling houses for removal during the 1890s recession (for less than cost – there was obviously no future in real estate!), as a Commercial Traveller (his occupation on his wedding certificate in 1902) and as a grocer, having his address as Vermont in the birth certificate of Ernest Frederick Carter in 1904, at which time he and his brother George ran the Vermont General Store prior to him running a grocer's shop in Union Road, Surrey Hills in the early 1920s.

He returned to real estate in 1923 under his own name in Ringwood, forming a partnership with his second son **Allan Ballard Carter** in 1947 before retiring from the partnership, and from business, in 1955.

The business that still bears the name of its founder celebrates its 80th Anniversary in 2003.

The Ancestors of Olive Maud Ballard

Olive Maud Ballard was born in Christchurch, New Zealand on 15th July 1877, the daughter of **Charles Ballard** and **Emily Grace Ballard (nee Tucker)**.

Charles Ballard was born in Edgeware, London, in 1844 and married **Emily Tucker**, who was born in Bristol in 1848, on 4th June 1866 in London.

Charles and Emily Ballard sailed from Middlesex on the SS "Eastern Monarch" on 7th May 1874 bound for Lyttleton Harbour, Christchurch, New Zealand where they landed on 22nd July 1874.

On board were their first two children, also known as Charles (8 years) and Emily (4 years).

The Birth of Olive Maud Ballard

Maud Mary Ballard was born on 15th July 1877 in Salisbury Street, Christchurch, to **Charles Ballard**, 33 years, occupation Bootmaker, and **Emily Ballard**.

Note that, some time over the next 25 years, the name "Olive" had been added to and "Mary" dropped from the name. Maud Mary Ballard became **Olive Maud Ballard**, and later, Olive Maud Carter.

A fourth child was born to Charles and Emily Ballard (the second in New Zealand) being **Rosina Ballard** in 1874.

The Move from Christchurch to Melbourne

Charles Ballard is believed to have carried on his trade as bootmaker in the Salisbury Street/Colombo Street area of Christchurch before taking the family across the Tasman to Melbourne.

When Charles and Emily made the move, and why, is yet to be established. Anecdotally it appears to have been when **Olive Maud Ballard** was about 10 years old. Shipping records, yet to be searched, will hold the answer.

Where they first lived in Melbourne is unknown. So, too, is when and why they moved to Whittlesea.

Unknown also is the answer to the Big Question: how did **Charles Ernest Carter**, who lived in Surrey Hills, meet **Olive Maud Ballard** of Whittlesea?

THE MARRIAGE

The marriage of **Charles Ernest Carter**, age 25, Commercial Traveller of Surrey Hills and **Olive Maud Mary Ballard**, age 25, Domestic of Whittlesea, was solemnised at Christ Church Whittlesea on 13th September 1902 by the Rev. Edward Charles Knox. The signatures of the bride and groom were witnessed by their respective fathers, **Charles Ballard** and **Henry Carter**.

Mr. and Mrs. C.E. Carter took up residence in Vermont in 1904 until they had built the family home at 18 Kireep Road, Balwyn in 1915. That home remained as the family home until sold by C.E. Carter in 1963.

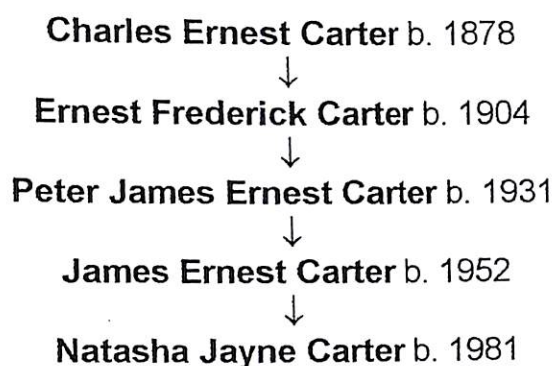

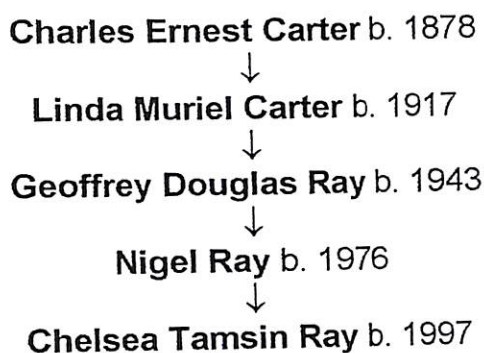

A Descendency Chart of **Charles Ernest Carter** identifies up to five generations of descendants. For example, tracing through Ern's line we have:

Since the ancestry of both **Charles Ernest Carter** and **Olive Mary Maud Ballard** can be traced back a further three generations, up to eight generations can now be counted.

It is not the purpose of these notes to delve further into the lives of the children, grandchildren and so forth of C.E. and O.M. Carter. That is a job for each biographer of each branch. The task here is to set out the structure of the family tree, as founded by the patriarch and matriarch one hundred years ago.

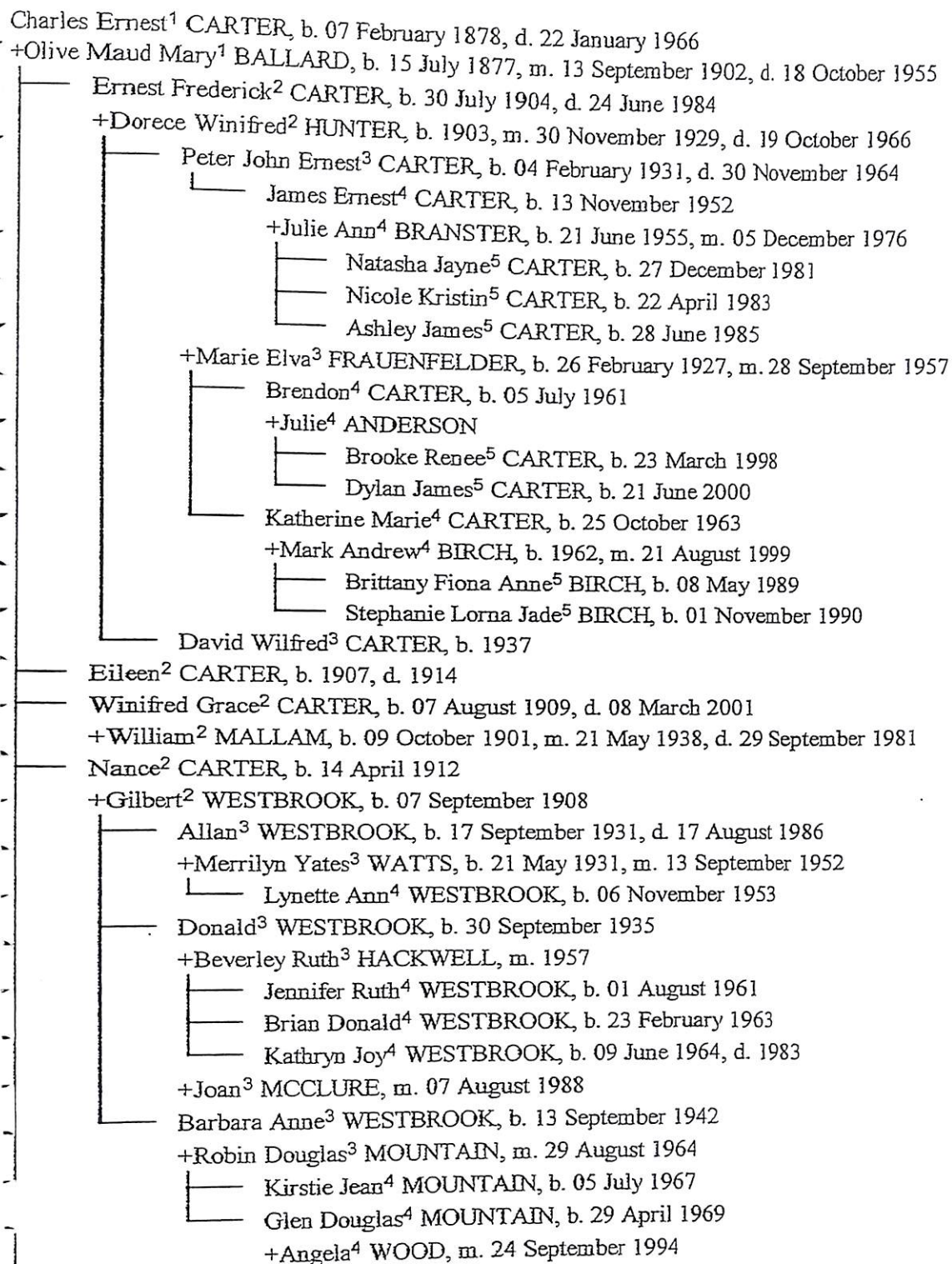
Olive Mary Carter died on 18th October 1955 at 18 Kireep Road, Balwyn, after a marriage of 53 years. **Charles Ernest Carter** died a little over ten years later on 22nd January 1966 at "Tamereca" Williams Road, North Ringwood.

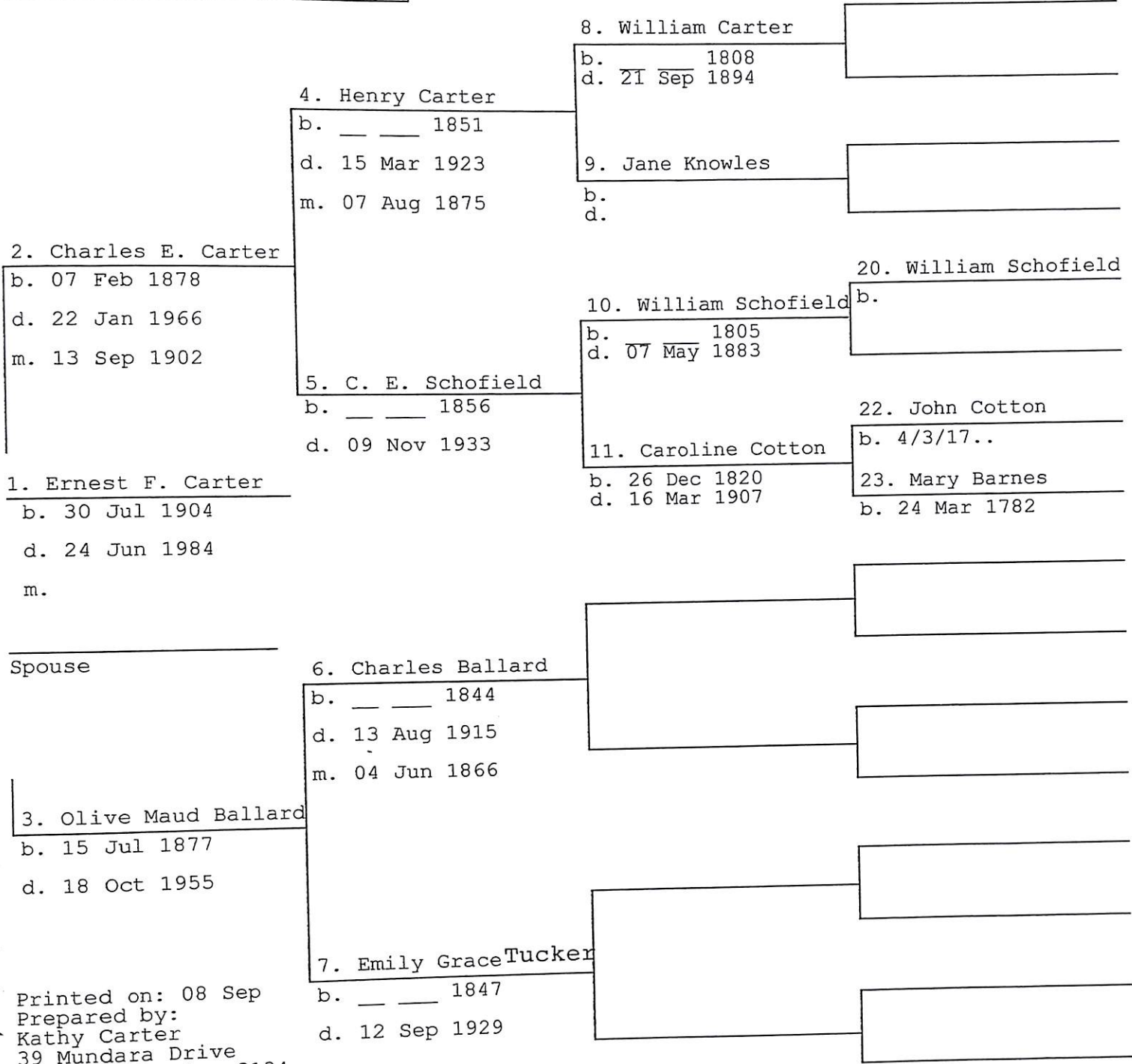

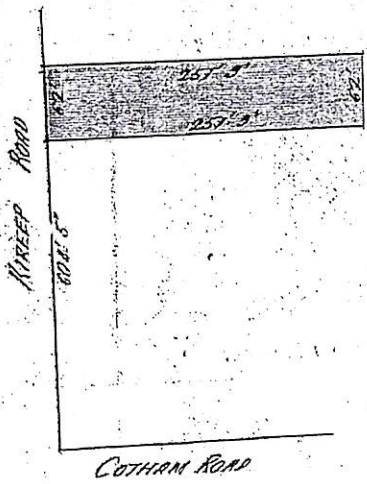

Dear Descendant

I have been doing a bit more sleuthing and have unearthed some more interesting facts about our honourable ancestors.

Firstly, in relation to the Ballards, it appears that Charles and Emily Ballard had eight children, born as follows:

I have Birth Certificates for Ethel May and Eva Rosaline confirming their birth date and parentage.

Of interest is that it was not Rosina Ballard (b1874) who was the daughter of Charles & Emily.

"Auntie Ros" or "Sister R.E. Ballard" was in fact E.R. Ballard (Eva Rosaline Ballard), who would have been 32 years old when in France in 1916.

The Ballard girls sure had a habit of changing their names!

Secondly, in relation to Charles Ernest Carter, I have had contact with a grandson of William Henry Carter who was Henry and Caroline Carter's eldest son and thus Charles Ernest Carter's elder brother.

From information supplied by Jeff Carter in Brisbane we can trace the tree back one further generation to:

William Carter and Jane Carter (nee Knowles) had four children:

We are of course descended from Henry's line.

It would appear Henry Carter came out to Australia with at least his brother William and possibly with his parents and three siblings. The year 1859 is suggested, which implies the whole family came out.

William Carter (Henry's brother) married Margaret Page in 1873 or 1874. They settled in Footscray and had nine children, who would have been cousins to Charles Ernest Carter. These were:

We have no record of Thomas Carter's life or any descendants.

It is interesting to note that William & Margaret Carter had nine children in mainly two yearly intervals from 1878 to 1895 whilst brother Henry and wife Caroline had ten children in two yearly intervals from 1876 to 1894.

Was there a competition?

We have also some further information about Caroline Eliza Carter (b 1856 in Emerald Hill) who was of course Charles Ernest Carter's mother and Henry Carter's wife.

Caroline Eliza Carter (nee Schofield) had a sister Florence Amelia Schofield (b 1854 England, d 8/9/1910 Melbourne). She married George Greenham in 1872 and had nine children between 1873 and 1891. (was Caroline therefore competing with her sister as well as with her sister-in-law?! Between the three of them they had 28 children in less than 20 years!).

Charles Ernest Carter's brother Bill had four children:

- Gifford Gordon Carter
- Cassie Carter
- Donald Linley Carter
- Phoebe Carter

Jeff Carter, who gave me this information (I stumbled upon him via the Internet) is the son of Donald Carter. Coincidentally I have amongst Charles Ernest Carter's papers correspondence from 1953 to 1960 between Chas and brother Bill and, upon William Henry Carter's death in 1960, correspondence from Gifford, Cassie, Donald and Phoebe. I have given Jeff copies.

It appeared that Chas continued to act as Executor of the Estate of Caroline Eliza Carter and made distribution to her heirs, including these four grandchildren. No wonder the letters to Uncle Chas were so polite, thanking him for their cheques for £39.14.0.

William Henry Carter was a baker with the logo of a Shepherd's Crook who sold "Crook Bread". His premises in Katherine, NT (circa 1940?) proclaimed:

"A loafer for 44 years and still making good dough".

They're a weird mob, these Carters!

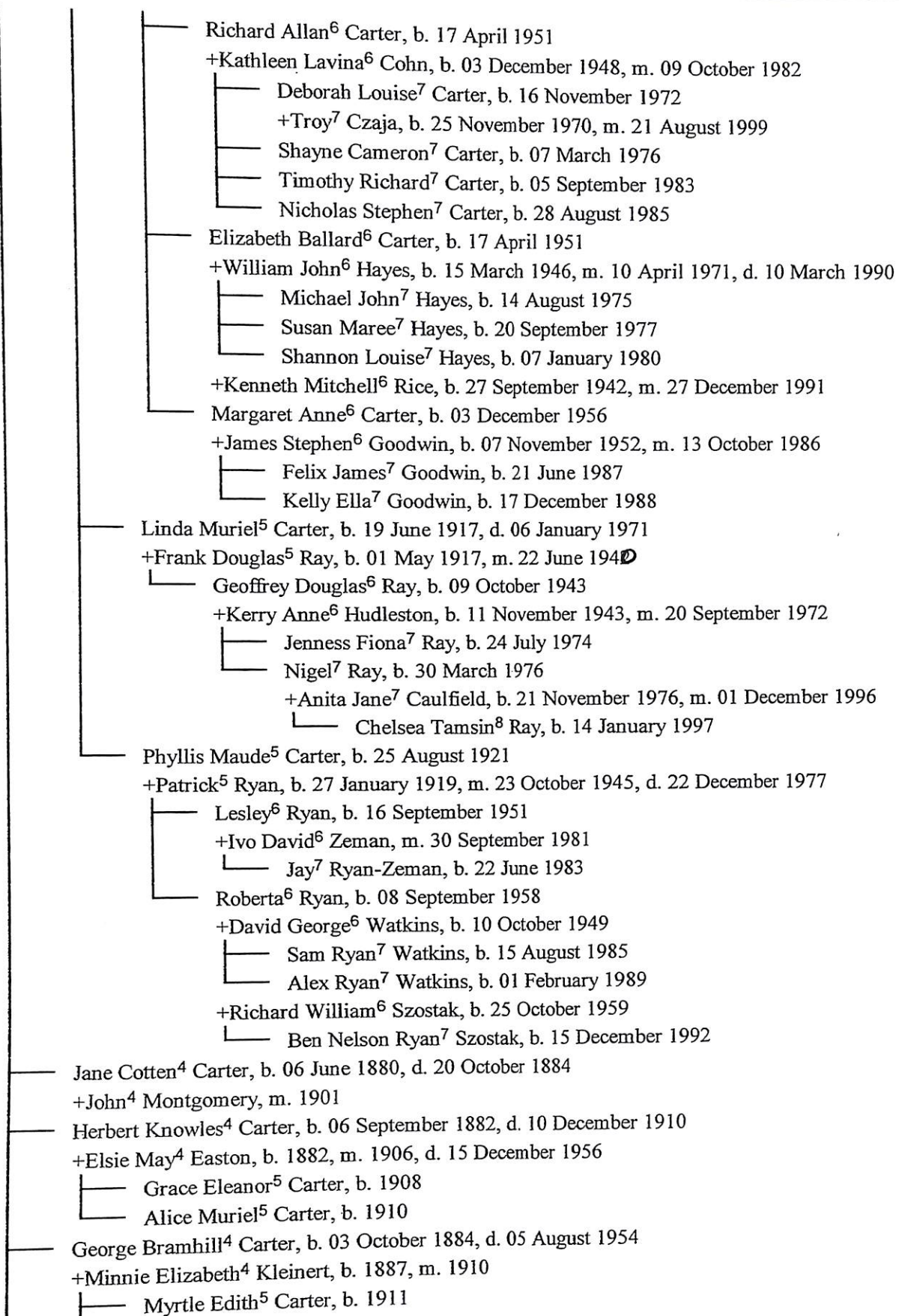

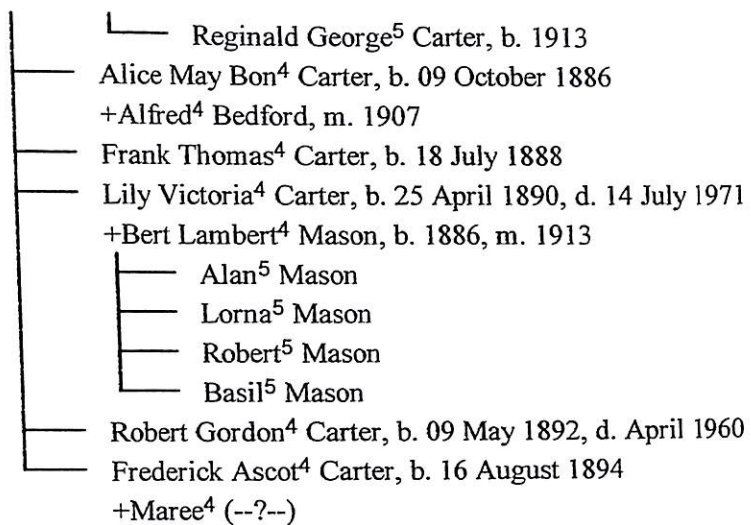

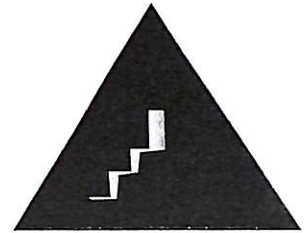
