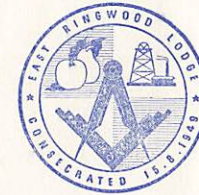

MASONIC DRESS.

By direction of the Board of General Purposes I have to draw your attention to the following Pronouncement made by M.W. Bro. His Excellency General Sir Dallas Brooks, Grand Master:—

"I desire to emphasise to Brethren the dignity and impressiveness which are added to the ceremonies and meetings of subordinate Lodges by the wearing of evening dress by all members present. "Evening dress with white tie and white vest, or where these are not available, dinner jacket with white tie, is the approved dress for evening meetings of Freemasons.

"During the war and the years immediately following, this rule was relaxed, but the reasons which led to its relaxation no longer exist.

"In exceptional circumstances Brethren may on occasion find it impossible to wear evening dress. In these instances Brethren should not refrain from attending their meetings, but their dress should be appropriate to the solemnity of our ceremonies, dark suits and white collars with either black or white ties and black shoes should be worn. Sports clothing will not be permitted. It will be the duty of Wor. Masters to see that these conditions are observed and that the circumstances are indeed exceptional.

"In other than these exceptional cases, however, it is my desire that Brethren should regularly wear the accepted Masonic Dress and the Lodge Secretaries should inform proposed candidates of their obligation in this regard."
