## MASONIC SCHOLARSHIPS

**KING EDWARD VII SCHOLARSHIPS**—Two Scholarships of an annual value of £50 tenable for four years, minimum standard Grade 8 or Form 2 (excluding Technical Schools), awarded annually on results of competitive examination to children under 14 years and 6 months on 1st January, 1964. Closing date: Tuesday, 1st October, '63.

**FREEMASONS' SCHOLARSHIPS** — Twenty-five Scholarships of an annual value or £50, awarded annually and tenable for up to four years, for all pupils who have completed Grade 8, Form 2, or equivalent or higher courses at any school, and will be under 18 years of age on 1st January, 1964. Entries close on Wednesday, 18th December, 1963.

**A. O. CAPELL SCHOLARSHIPS** — Scholarships of an annual value of £120, tenable from year to year for each of the following: Ballarat College (2), Ballarat Grammar School (2), and the University of Melbourne (2) for descendants of ex-servicemen of the 1939-45 World War who are, or were, at any time subscribing members of a Masonic Lodge meeting in or within a radius of 25 miles of Ballarat. Entries for the School Scholarships close on Tuesday, 1st October, 1963, and for the University on Wednesday, 18th December, 1963. (Available only if current Scholarships are not renewed.)

**LEMPRIERE PRIZE** — A Bursary of £100 per annum for the Child of a Freemason who is (or was, if deceased) a subscribing member of a Victorian Lodge. The Bursary will be awarded in general on the results of the Matriculation examinations: candidates must be residents of Victoria and under 19 years of age on 1st January, 1964, and in need of assistance to pursue an approved post-school course.
