"Notwithstanding anything contained in these By-laws, the Lodge is prohibited from making any distribution, whether in money, property or otherwise howsoever, of any assets belonging to the Lodge, to its members. Provided, however, that this By-law shall not prevent payment in good faith of remuneration to any officers or servants of the Lodge or of Benevolent payments for which provision is made in the By-laws".

DRAFT BY-LAW

(Memorial Temple Building Fund)

Notwithstanding anything contained in these By-laws in order to provide the Lodge with funds to enable it to make its contributions to Grand Lodge under the provisions of Rule 274c of the Book of Constitutions, for a period of twenty years from the 1st day of January 1956 each member shall pay to the Lodge a further and additional sum of \$2.00 per year at the same time and on the same condition as he pays the annual subscription referred to in By-law No.....

PROVIDED THAT in the event of any member being a subscribing member of any other Lodge which appears prior to this Lodge on the register of the United Grand Lodge of Victoria, then during the period of his membership of such Lodge and upon proof to the Secretary of this Lodge of his payment of all dues to such Lodge he shall not be required to pay to this Lodge the said annual sum of \$2.00.

AND PROVIDED FURTHER that a member shall not be required to pay to the Lodge the said annual sum of \$2.00 if he shall on or before the 30th day of June, 1966, have paid to Grand Lodge the sum of \$20.00 in satisfaction of the monies due by the Lodge in respect of such member under the said rule 274c for the period 1st January, 1966 to the 31st December, 1975 and shall produce to the Secretary of the Lodge a Certificate of such payment given by or on behalf of the Grand Secretary.
