1. KING EDWARD VII SCHOLARSHIPS — Two Scholarships of an annual value of \$100 tenable for four years, minimum standard Grade 8 or Form 2, awarded annually to children under 14 years and 6 months, on 1st January, 1969. Closing date: Monday, 7th October, 1968.
2. FREEMASONS' SCHOLARSHIPS — Fifty Scholarships of an annual value of \$100, awarded annually and tenable for up to two years, for all pupils who have completed Grade 8, Form 2, or equivalent courses at any school, and will be under 14 years and 6 months on 1st January, 1969. Entries close on Monday, 7th October, 1968.
3. A. O. CAPELL SCHOLARSHIPS — Scholarships of an annual value of \$240, tenable from year to year for each of the following: Ballarat College (2), Ballarat Grammar School (2), and the University of Melbourne (2), for descendants of ex-servicemen of the 1939-1945 World War who are, or were, at any time subscribing members of a Masonic Lodge meeting in or within a radius of 25 miles of Ballarat. Entries for the School Scholarships close on Monday, 7th October, 1968, and for the University on Wednesday, 11th December, 1968. (Available only if current Scholarships are not renewed.)
4. LEMPRIERE PRIZE — A Bursary of \$200 per annum for the child of a Freemason who is (or was, if deceased) a subscribing member of a Victorian Lodge. The Bursary will be awarded, in general, on the results of the Matriculation examinations; candidates must be residents of Victoria and under 19 years of age on 1st January, 1969, and in need of assistance to pursue an approved post-school course.
