 Wiping up the tears upon the soft leather.

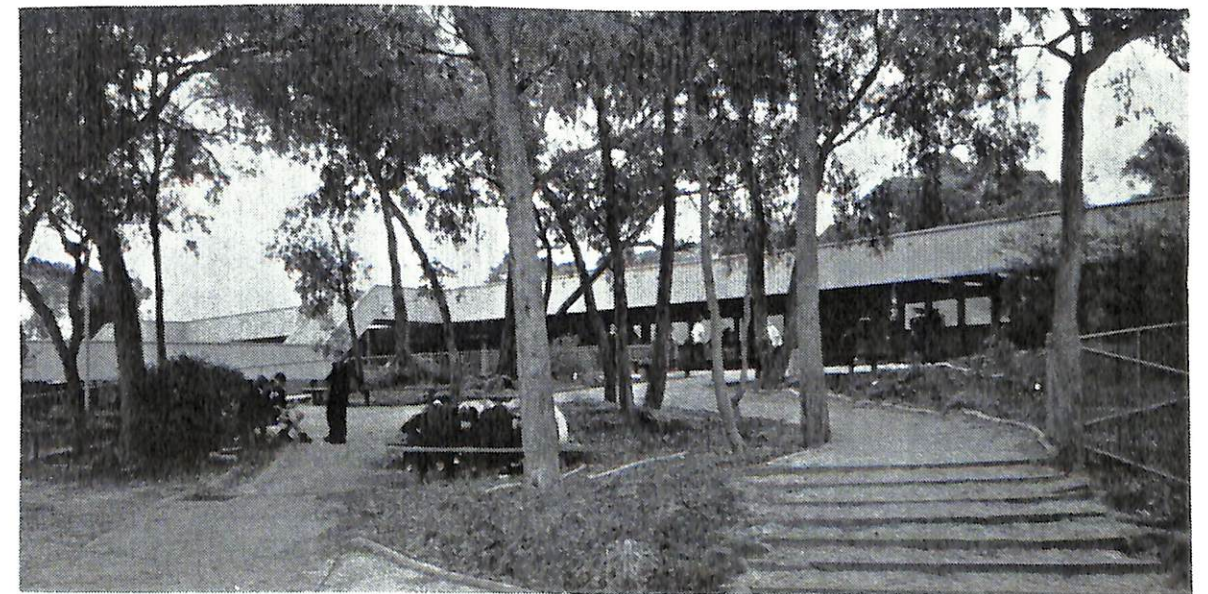
