Thousands of people throughout Australia will continue to write to Mr. J. B. Williams, Manager, Mail Order Dept., Pleasant Hill.

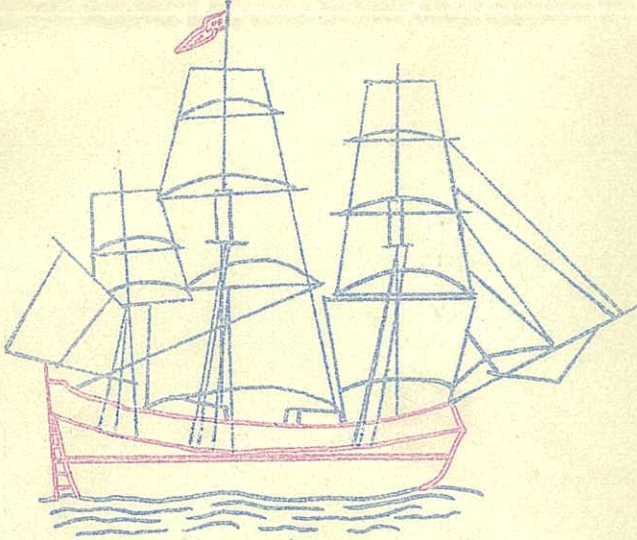
They have seen Jim's signature over and over again on Mail Order letters coming to them.
