To obtain a kit of six colors, gilding clay, antique gold and brushes required in decorating the model, we would suggest that you correspond with the D.M. Campana Company, 316 W. Grand Ave., Chicago, Ill. Almost any crack filler can be used instead of plastic wood for making the imitation carvings. This material is available from practically all concerns handling supplies for home craftsmen, such as the Craftsman's Wood Service Co., 2727 S. Mary Street, Chicago, Ill.
