

JUDGES' REPORT

The 1993 Awards, the first national competition conducted by the Royal Agricultural Society of Victoria Inc. in conjunction with Ballarat University College, was a successful event which attracted 124 entries in 17 classes.

The number of entries in most classes was encouraging, although a lack of interest was evident for some Draught classes and for Stout and other high gravity beers. Some specific comments follow.

Open Section

AWARD

<u>Lagers & Ales</u> - even quality with most entries achieving Silver or Bronze status.

<u>Reduced Alcohol Beers</u> - standard generally indifferent with many entries showing major faults.

Stouts & Draught Beers - limited entries, standard generally good.

Small Brewery Section

Lagers, Ales & Stouts - quality variable with only a few achieving Bronze plus one Silver, many showed major faults.

Draught Beers - quality even with most reaching Bronze status.

Draught beers - quality even with most reaching bronze statu

Specialty Section

Dry & Extra-Light Beers - quality disappointing; one Dry Beer reached Bronze. Wheat Beers - variable with one exception.

International Section

Lagers & Ales - even quality with most entries achieving Silver or Bronze status.

The standard of entries in the <u>Open and International Sections</u> was, in general, better than that achieved at most competitions conducted at <u>Ballarat</u> in the period 1987 - 1991

The variable quality of entries in the packaged classes of the <u>Small Brewery Section</u> suggests that many smaller breweries are perhaps better suited to produce high quality draught beers rather than packaged products.

Entries in the <u>Specialty Section</u> varied widely in quality and this possibly confirms the difficulties that can be encountered in brewing such beers.

It is most encouraging that 28 individual breweries (14 each in Australia and New Zealand) entered the Open, Small Brewery and Specialty Sections but it is very disappointing that a few major brewers in both Australia and New Zealand did not participate in the Awards. It is to be hoped that future events will attract an even broader cross-section of active brewers in both countries.
