That in the event of the Government deciding on carrying out the Geological Survey of the District that permission be requested for the Master of the School to accompany the officers of the Geological Department with the pupils. Carried

That Mr. Fisher's resignation be accepted with regret and that a letter to that effect be written to him. Carried
