The members of the Governing Body of the School, The Examiners, Lecturers & Students, Donors and the Commanders of several regiments. In all about 900 copies have been issued.

Examinations

Matriculation Examinations

The Professorial Board of the University has asked for the use of the Lecture Hall on the 1st, 2nd & 3rd December; it is thought there will be 40 Candidates up, and that a gentleman will be specially appointed at a fixed Fee to superintend the Examinations. It is suggested that 12 more chairs be purchased for the use of the School, which can also be used on the occasions of such Examinations instead of hiring chairs; the usual charge being paid, in course of time the School will possess very useful property at little or no cost.
