Passed by the Council, 30th April, 1874.

METALLURGY ASSAYING AND INORGANIC CHEMISTRY.

ARTICLE 1.—Before any Candidate for Examination in Metallurgy Assaying or Inorganic Chemistry shall be entered for Examination the Superintendent of Laboratories shall lodge with the Registrar a Certificate of the Candidate's efficiency in Laboratory-work upon being satisfied of such efficiency by such tests as the Superintendent shall think necessary.

ARTICLE 2.—Such Certificate shall be in the form following and shall not be taken out of The School.
