EXAMINATION STATUTE.

Passed by the Council, 15th October, 1874.

ARTICLE 1.—That Examinations be held twice a year in the Art of Telegraphy and that Certificates of Proficiency be issued by the Council upon the report of the Examiners.

ARTICLE 2.—That the fee of £1 1s. be paid for a Certificate in Telegraphy.

ARTICLE 3.—That successful Candidates be classed in such manner as the Examiners deem fitting.

ARTICLE 4.—Before any Candidate for Examination in Telegraphy shall be entered for Examination the Lecturer shall lodge with the Registrar a Certificate of the Candidate's efficiency in the manipulation of Instruments.
