

A commission of 10% to be allowed the Collector on all annual subscriptions by Governors and 5% on amounts received by him for the Rates Fund and on account of sums paid as special donations and for life Governors etc. The Council authorizing a Commission to be paid on sums exceeding £1.00 if in the opinion of the Administrative Council the Collector has by his diligence been instrumental in obtaining same. The Administrative Council to determine any question which may arise touching the Commission. Collector to receive 20p weekly for Clerical labor he undertaking to perform at least 10 hours such duty per week.

Professor Liveridge.

Mr. Harry Wood of Sydney being already appointed as Hon. Correspondent it was resolved to confer with that Gentleman prior to notifying Prof. Liveridge of the Council's acceptance of his services. but so soon as a favorable reply was received from Mr. Wood then Prof. Liveridge was accordingly informed. Mr. Barnard having thanked the Vice-President and members of Council for the honor conferred on him, the Council adjourned at 10 P.M.
