On the consideration of Mr Lecturer Thomas' letter asking for an increase in rate of remuneration it was resolved that a letter be written in reply informing Mr Thomas that the Administrative Council recognizing the fact that the remuneration at present given to each Lecturer was inadequate had determined to recommend to the Council at the next meeting to increase the same by allowing each Lecturer to receive half the fees paid by the students attending their several classes, in addition to the Honorarium now paid to the Lecturers.

A letter was directed to be written to the Council of the University asking payment of the expenses incurred in providing for the late examinations (Maturations) and which the City & Town Councils had declined to recognize.

The Accounts amounting to £32.1.1 were ordered to be paid: also an expenditure of £2 for pencil polishing several Cases to be incurred.

The question of advertising in the Training Journal was postponed to next meeting in the absence of Councillor Sergeant.

Leave to the Registrar pro tem was approved to commence at such time as he found it convenient in the interests of the School
This Council adjourned at 10 P.M.
