That a Committee consisting of the Vice-President & Councillors Russell, Caselli, Lewis Sargeant and Bamaid be appointed to watch ^{over} the interests of the School in the matter of Grant-in-aid of Schools of Mines and generally to take measures for increasing the revenue of the School.

That the Registrar communicate through the Hon. Correspondents in Sydney with the Government of N.S. Wales as to testing at cost prices the Waste Products & recently advised by that Government to be collected by the Mining Registrars.

That a letter of similar import be written to the Government of Victoria.

A conversation took place relative to the propriety of Quarterly Conversaciones of the Council, Examiners, Lecturers, Certificated Students, Honorary and other Officers of the School but no resolution was arrived at.
