Business. 1. To consider the present financial position of the School. The portion of the balance of the Vote £1800 in aid of School of Mines 1874-5 recently received having been absorbed.

2. To consider proposal of Superintendent of Laboratories to rent one of the offices to enable him to carry on the business of a Gold buyer. His receipts from the School since not producing a sufficient income.

It was resolved

1. That the Vice-President be requested to place the Minister of Mines in possession of the facts of the case, and to endeavor to secure from him if the Council will be justified in assurance of Government support in maintaining the School.
2. That the Council had not any power to act in the manner desired.
